

INSTRUCTIONS:

SCRAMBLE

- 1. Captains prepare cards, they do not have to be stroked.
- 2. Captains collect \$2.25 before playing, remind their team to be aware of "pace of play", add "Start Time" and "End Time" to their score cards. Also calculate and record the elapsed time on the card before turning it in to the scorers.
- 3. Two players keep score. All team players' names are on the card, but only the team score on each hole gets recorded on the card. Place a "D" on each hole to indicate which player's drive was used. Since it is best ball, there will be no individual scores.

4.

- 4.1. Each team member hits the tee shot and the best ball is selected. The person whose ball is chosen does not hit the next shot. All other players do.
- 4.2. Continue in this manner until everyone is on the green. Everyone putts. Continue in this manner using the BEST BALL on the green until someone gets the ball in the hole. DO NOT USE CONTINUOUS PUTTING.
- 4.3. Each player must have at least two drives.
- 4.4. As in team play, threesomes will subtract 1 stroke from their gross score.
- 5. Scores are not entered in the computer.
