

FOUR CLUBS AND A PUTTER

INDIVIDUAL PLAY FORMAT

- 1. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
- 2 Captains will place each player's handicap in the "HCP" (handicap) column on the scorecard. Handicap cannot be greater than 27.
- 3. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will remind their team to be aware of "pace of play". Captains will add "Start Time" and "End Time" to their score cards, and calculate and record the elapsed time on the card before turning it in to the scorers.
- 4. Choose four clubs (and putter) to bring on the course. All other clubs must be left in your vehicle. Captains will check team members before play to verify bags contain only four clubs and a putter. Sharing of clubs not allowed.
- 5. Players pick up after 8, 9, or 10 strokes "Equitable Stroke Control"

Course Handicap	Maximum strokes
10-14	8
15-19	9
20 or more	10

- 6. Gross scores should be entered in the "Tot" column.
- 7. Net score should be entered in the "net" column. Subtract handicap from gross score to determine net score.
- 8. Scores are not entered into the computer.
