



FAIRWAYS AND PUTTS

INDIVIDUAL PLAY

RINGERS

1. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
2. Captains should prepare 2 scorecards with names and CGC numbers. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will also remind their team to be aware of “pace of play”. At the end of the round, the Captains should turn in one scorecard, signed and attested plus the money to the Scorers.
3. Players hitting their tee shot on the Fairway receive 5 points. (If you do not hit the fairway, you will have no tournament score for the hole).
 - a. If your tee shot lands on the green or on the fringe around the green, you receive 5 points. You do not receive 5 points if your tee shot lands in the short rough around the green.
4. Once you are on the green, you subtract 1 point for every putt it takes you to hole out your ball. This is your tournament score for the hole. As an example, on Hole #11, you hit the ball on the fairway. Once you reach the green, it takes you 2 putts to hole out. Your tournament score for the hole is 3. On Hole #12, you hit your tee shot into the rough. You receive no points and have no tournament score for that hole.
5. 1st and 2nd prize will be presented to those players with the highest scores in each flight and on each course. In the event, this format is played on only one course, there will be 4 prizes per flight.
6. Captains and co-Captains are responsible for keeping everyone’s tournament score.
7. Individuals should keep track of their own gross score regardless so they may be posted into the GHIN system.
