

CGC Women's Nine Hole Association Board Meeting November 3, 2025

The meeting was conducted in person at Freeman's Grill, Captain's Golf Course

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. by Cindy Davey.

Secretary's Report: A motion was made by Paulette Goeden, seconded by Kathleen Barry, to approve the October 2025 minutes. The motion passed by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report: Paulette Goeden reported that the balance available for operations is \$3022.33. Payment for Autumn Leaves is still pending and holiday gifts for six Captain's employees are planned.

A discussion was had regarding the annual charitable donation. A motion was made by Sharon Marotti and seconded by Anne O'Connell, "To donate \$200 to the Family Pantry in Harwich." Motion was passed unanimously.

Paulette inquired about the renewal of our domain name. Sharon Marotti indicated that it will be due in January.

Paulette will investigate status of our checks sent to Lower Cape Outreach as they have not been cashed yet.

Vice President/Membership Report: Deb Vierra indicated that nothing has changed regarding membership. She will advise the three members who were unable to play this year due to medical reasons that their membership will carry over to the 2026 season (they will pay \$5.00 to cover the increase for 2026 only). The three members are Linda Frazette, Maggie Weber and Marcy Lippold.

Ringers: Deb Vierra will be tallying ringers results and monetary prizes will be awarded at the holiday luncheon in December.

Communications/Golf Commission: Anne O'Connell will continue communications during the off season. The plan is to transition from Yahoo to Gmail during the off season for 2026. Anne is going to ask Susan Sorrento to assist with this. Anne indicated that the 2026 course calendar is scheduled to be approved at the November golf commission meeting.

Pairings: Anne O'Connell indicated that the committee plans to work on updating the documentation of the pairings process over the off season.

Scoring: Margaret Litavis reported that scoring is all set for 2026, with Karen Whitney and Peggy McEvoy joining the group. She will set up training for them next season.

Website: Sharon Marotti indicated that Susan Sorrento will be leading this group going forward. Marj DeVault and Sharon will continue to assist as needed. Paulette asked about the Hole In One list, which Sharon indicated will be available on the website.

Sunshine: Kathleen Barry indicated that she sent out several cards this past month for various reasons. People should continue to advise her during the off season of any cards to be sent.

Social: Kathy Turieo sent out a blast regarding the holiday party, scheduled for Thursday, December 4th, 1:00 p.m. at the Blue Island Crab in Brewster.

Tournaments/Prizes: Donna Potts indicated that the 2026 schedule has been submitted for approval by Captain's. Anne O'Connell advised that any changes to the schedule after it's approved need to be communicated to the pairings group as it is tied to golf genius.

Discussion was had regarding the most improved player award. A motion was made by Donna Potts, seconded by Kathleen Barry, that eligible players must have played in league play 50% of the year. The calculation of handicap improvement will be done by Jay. Cindy will get the list from Jay and she will work with Margaret Litavis (Scoring) to validate that the winner played 50% of the league year. Anne O'Connell will add this criteria to the league policies document.

Invitational: Cindy Davey reported for Nancy Purpura and Michelle Litavis. The name of the invitational has been finalized as "A Ladies Masters at Captains".

There was discussion about what courses should be included in the invitational. It was decided that the courses who will be invited are: Bass River, Cranberry Valley, Dennis, Kingsway and Chequesett.

Other Business: Next year there will need to be a nominating committee to elect new officers for the 2027/2028 seasons. The committee will be comprised of three people. This will be discussed further in 2026 when meetings resume.

A motion was made by Sharon Marotti, seconded by Paulette Goeden, to adjourn the meeting at 11:30 a.m.. The motion passed unanimously.
