



FORMAT: WHO'S ODD ENOUGH - INDIVIDUAL PLAY (LN)

~ RINGERS

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Captains prepare two cards with player's names and CGC numbers.
 - a. Each player's handicap (HCP) should be noted in the HCP column
 - b. Cards do not need to be stroked
 - c. Remember to note no more than 27 handicap on the scorecard for those players who may have a higher handicap on the Pairings sheet.
 - d. Start and finish times, along with elapsed time for the round should also be noted on cards
2. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player before playing, reminding all to be aware of "pace of play".
3. Captain and Co-Captain keep score.
4. Players announce number of strokes when they reach the green
5. In this format: Only the scores for the odd numbered holes count; 11, 13, 15 & 17
 - a. However, each player should keep their own individual score for GHIN
6. At the end of the round scores for the odd numbered holes will be totaled, then the players HCP will be subtracted from the total.
 - a. It is possible this may result in a negative number
7. Net* score should be noted in the "NET" column on card.
 - a. *Subtract players handicap from their Gross Score to determine Net score
8. 1st and 2nd place will be awarded on each course in each flight for the players who have the lowest net scores. In the event of a tie, cards will be matched using only the odd numbered holes
9. Players' individual Gross scores are to be entered into the GHIN system.
