

CGC Women's Nine Hole Association Board Meeting June 1, 2026

The meeting was conducted in person at Freemans Grill, Captain's Golf Course.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Cindy Davey.

Secretary's Report: A motion was made by Paulette Goeden, seconded by Susan Olin, to approve the corrected May 2026 minutes. The motion passed by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report: Paulette Goeden reported that the balance available for operations in the 2026 Budget was \$4,966.80 as of 5/31/26.

The \$500 Scholarship money will be awarded to the Nauset High School female student golfer on June 1st.

Vice President/Membership Report: Deb Vierra reported that we have 62 members as of 6/1/26. There are 15 new members, 13 new to our league and 2 renewed members from last season. So far so good with all the new members.

Communications: Cindy Davey reported for Anne O'Connell there is no news this month from this committee.

Pairings: Joanne Cirincione reported that Susan Sorrento joined the Pairings committee. Cindy Davey asked if the Pairings committee can add "Pace of Play" directions to each week's tournament description.

Golf Commission: Cindy Davey reported for Anne O'Connell there is no news from the Golf Commission this month. They meet again next week.

Scoring: Margaret Litavis reported that all is good with her committee. She will find the next date to do a "Pace of Play" audit.

Website: Susan Sorrento reported that when she speaks at our Welcome Coffee on June 4th, she will guide the group on how to add our website icon to our phones.

Sunshine: Cindy reported for Kathleen Barry that no new cards were sent last month.

Social: Kathy Turieo reported that we have 42 members signed up to attend our Welcome Back Coffee on June 4th. She has proposed June 26th to Colin as the date we will pay for a crew lunch. She is waiting to hear back from him to confirm. We have \$232.75 in the budget leftover from last year. We will ask the members for a \$10 donation to defray the costs.

Tournaments/Prizes: Donna Potts reported that the O'Connell Cup is underway with 9 golfers participating. Marie Macrorie has taken over the Birdies and Under 50's tracking and pins. The next event is Flay Day on June 11th.

Invitational: Cindy Davey reported for Nancy Purpura and Michelle Litavis. They are

working on menus at the moment. Event date is September 3, 2026.

Other Business: Cindy Davey reported that Jon Mohan runs the PGA Jr golfer program at Captains GC. Anne O'Connell had asked at last month's meeting if we would like to use some of the scholarship money to support a couple young golfers in the program. The question is when do we begin to do this: this season or next? We will discuss at our next meeting on June 29th, 2026.

Cindy Davey reported that she noticed a discrepancy in wording between our By-laws and our Policy & Procedures documents. The topic is "Most Improved Player" and how players are considered eligible.

A motion was made by Paulette Goeden, seconded by Susan Olin to amend our Policy & Procedures document to match the language in our By-Laws document. "To be eligible for "Most Improved Player", an individual needs to be a member of the CGC 9-Hole Women's Association for at least one season and have played a minimum of 8 times with the league." The motion was passed by unanimous consent.
