



INSTRUCTIONS:

WHO'S ODD ENOUGH? LOW NET ONLY INDIVIDUAL PLAY MUST BE PLAYED ON TWO COURSES RINGERS

1. The Captain should prepare two scorecards with names, CGC numbers and handicaps for all her teammates. The maximum handicap is 27 even for those players who may have a higher handicap on the Pairings Sheet.
2. Cards do not need to be stroked. The Captain will collect \$2.25 from each team member. At the end of the round, the Captain will turn in one scorecard, signed and attested, plus the money to the Scorers.
3. In this format, only the scores on the odd numbered holes count (11,13,15,17).
4. All players will keep their own individual score so they can be entered into the GHIN system. The Captain and Co-Captain will also keep the format score for all their teammates. After each of the odd numbered holes, each player will advise the Captains of their score for that odd numbered hole. At the end of the round these scores should be totaled and then the player's handicap should be subtracted from the total. (It is possible that this might result in a negative number).
5. 1st and 2nd place will be awarded on each course in each flight for the players who have the lowest net scores. In the event of a tie, cards will be matched using only the odd numbered holes.
6. All players should announce how many strokes they have taken once they reach the green.
7. All players will pick up after 10 strokes.
