

FAIRWAYS AND PUTTS

RINGERS

- 1. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
- 2. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will also remind their team to be aware of "pace of play".
- 3. Players hitting their tee shot on the Fairway receive 5 points. (If you do not hit the fairway, you will have no tournament score for the hole).
- 4. Once you are on the green, you subtract 1 point for every putt it takes you to hole out your ball. This is your tournament score for the hole.
 - a. As an example, on Hole #11, you hit the ball on the fairway. Once you reach the green, it takes you 2 putts to hole out. Your tournament score for the hole is 3. On Hole #12, you hit your tee shot into the rough. You receive no points and have no tournament score for that hole.
- 5. 1st and 2nd prize will be presented to those players with the highest scores in each flight.
- 6. Captains and co-Captains are responsible for keeping everyone's tournament score.
- 7. Individuals should keep track of their own gross score regardless so they may be posted into the GHIN system.
