

INSTRUCTIONS:

FLAG DAY (LG/LN) RINGERS

INDIVIDUAL PLAY FORMAT

- 1. Golf attire: If possible, golfers are requested to wear red, white, and/or blue.
- 2. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
- 3. Captains will place each player's handicap in the "HCP" (handicap) column on the scorecard. Handicap cannot be greater than 27. Captains will collect flags for their team at the small table in the hallway by the restrooms.
- 4. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will also remind their team to be aware of "pace of play".
- 5. Players pick up after 10 strokes.
- 6. Your number (par (36) + handicap) is on your flag. Place flag on course when your total strokes match the number on your flag. If on green, place to side. If you have strokes left, bring flag into the clubhouse. If you reach your flag number with your last putt, you should not bring in your flag.
- 7. Port: No. 15 closest to pin (on the green); No. 18 closest to the line
- 8. Starboard No. 17 closest to pin (on the green); No. 13 closest to the line
- 9. Last team brings in flags and distance markers.
- 9. Gross scores should be entered in the "Tot" column.
- 10. Net score should be entered in the "net" column. Subtract handicap from gross score to determine net score. Prizes are awarded for net score only.
- 11. Each individual player must enter their gross score into the GHIN system.
