### INDIVIDUAL PLAY FORMAT

LOW NET ONLY

RINGERS

1. Golf attire: If possible, golfers are requested to wear red, white, and/or blue.
2. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
3. Captains will prepare 2 scorecards with names, CGC numbers and handicaps. Captains will place each player's handicap in the "HCP" (handicap) column on the scorecard. Handicap cannot be greater than 27 even for those plyers who may have a higher handicap on the Pairings Sheet. Captains will collect flags for their whole team at the beginning of the round prior to going to their first hole.
4. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will also remind their team to be aware of "pace of play".
5. Your number (par (36) + handicap) is on your flag. Place flag on course when your total strokes match the number on your flag. If on green, place to side. If you have strokes left, bring flag into the clubhouse.
6. All players pick up after 10 strokes
7. Gross scores should be entered in the "Tot" column.
8. Net score should be entered in the "net" column. Subtract handicap from gross score to determine net score. **Prizes are awarded for net score only.**
9. Individuals will enter scores into the GHIN system
10. Last team on each course bring in all flags.
