



FORMAT: FAIRWAYS AND PUTTS - INDIVIDUAL PLAY

~ RINGERS

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Captains prepare two cards with player's names and CGC numbers.
 - a. Cards do not need to be stroked
2. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player before playing, reminding all to be aware of "pace of play".
3. Captain and Co-Captain keep the tournament format score.
4. Players hitting their tee shot onto the Fairway, receive 5 points.
 - a. If you do not hit the fairway, you will not have a tournament score for the hole
5. Players hitting their tee shot onto the green, or on the fringe around the green, receive 5 points.
 - a. You do not receive 5 points if your tee shot lands in the short rough around the green
6. Once you're on the green, you subtract 1 point for each putt it takes you to hole out
 - a. This will be your tournament score for that hole

EXAMPLES:

On hole #11 you hit your tee shot onto the fairway (5pts). Once you reach the green, it takes you 2 putts to hole out (-2pts). Your tournament score for that hole = 3pts.

On hole #12 you hit your tee shot into the rough. This results in zero points, therefore no tournament score for that hole.

7. 1st and 2nd place will be awarded to the players with the HIGHEST scores in each flight on each course. In the event this format is played on one course, there will be 4 prizes per flight.
8. Each player should also keep their own score.
9. Players' individual Gross scores are to be entered into the GHIN system.
