



FORMAT: FLAG DAY - INDIVIDUAL PLAY (LN)

~ RINGERS

*Golf Attire: If possible, golfers are encouraged to wear **Red**, **White** and/or **Blue***

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Captains prepare two cards with player's names and CGC numbers.
 - a. Each player's handicap (HCP) should be noted in the HCP column
 - b. Cards do not need to be stroked
 - c. Remember to note no more than 27 handicap on the scorecard for those players who may have a higher handicap on the Pairings sheet.
 - d. Start and finish times, along with elapsed time for the round should also be noted on cards
2. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player before playing, reminding all to be aware of "pace of play".
3. Captain and Co-Captain keep score.
4. All players pick up after 10 shots, regardless of handicap
5. In this format: Each player receives a Flag with your number on it (36 (par) + your HCP). Place the Flag on the course when your total strokes match the number of your flag. If on the green, place your flag to the side.
6. If you have any remaining strokes, bring your flag into the clubhouse. If you reach your flag number with your last putt, you should not bring in your flag, leave it on the side of the green.
7. **Last Team on the course brings in the flags**
8. Gross scores should be entered into the "Tot" column
9. Net* score should be noted in the "NET" column on card.
 - a. *Subtract players handicap from their Gross Score to determine Net score
10. Lowest Net scores will be awarded prize for each course
11. Players' individual Gross scores are to be entered into the GHIN system.
