

CGC Women's Nine Hole Association Board Meeting April 13, 2026

The meeting was conducted in person at Freemans Grill, Captain's Golf Course

Attendees: Cindy Davey, Mary Cornetta-Brown, Paulette Goeden, Anne O'Connell, Donna Potts, Margaret Litavis, Susan Sorrento, Kathleen Barry, Kathy Turieo, Susan Olin

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Cindy Davey.

Secretary's Report: A motion was made by Paulette Goeden, seconded by Donna Potts, to approve the November 2025 minutes. The motion passed by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report: Paulette Goeden reported that the balance available for operations in the final 2025 Budget was \$2,605.33 as of 12/31/2025.

She shared the Budget for 2026 based on 62 members. Paulette budgeted \$300 for the Invitational tournament in September. The budget would have a \$168 deficit. A motion was made by Anne O'Connell, seconded by Kathleen Barry to approve the budget. The motion was passed by unanimous consent.

She shared the Thank you note from the Family Pantry in Harwich for our charitable donation from December 2025.

Vice President/Membership Report: Cindy Davey reported for Deb Vierra that we have 58 members, including 10 new members.

Deb Vierra has met with most of the new members and if you can golf with one of them before league play in May, please contact Cindy Davey for contact information.

Communications: Anne O'Connell reported that Yahoo, not Gmail will be used for Communications within the league members. The first sign-up email will come on 4/26/26 for league play on May 7th. Anne will email the Board before the May meeting a copy of the updated Policies and Procedures Document. The Board will vote to approve in May.

Pairings: Anne O'Connell reported that the committee worked to update, streamline and make consistent all the documentation coming from the Pairings Committee. One outcome will be to remove the list of indexes from the website. The pairings committee is looking for another member.

Golf Commission: Anne O'Connell reported that there has been a lot of discussion about "Pace of Play" by the GC. Our league play should not take longer than 2.5 hours each week. She suggested a periodic audit. Action: Pairings Committee will announce in their weekly sign-up email when an audit will take place. The Board will decide in May to discuss what will be discussed in our Welcome Back Coffee so members know what to do when asked to track time for that week. And track what you see during play and report to Cindy any issues with Pace of Play or Ready Golf.

Golf Commission discussed and shared: Do Not Park Carts off the Cart Paths onto Dirt paths.

Scoring: Margaret Litavis reported that scoring is all set for 2026 with 8 members, with Karen Whitney joining the group. She showed the Board a red binder which contains all the information on Scoring. It is updated for 2026 and will be kept in the Ladies Restroom in a cabinet/drawer.

Website: Susan Sorrento (new chairperson) reported that the website is refreshed and updated. She asked the Board for discussion on any outstanding items/questions she had. Send any feedback to her regarding the new website.

Sunshine: Kathleen Barry reported that members should continue to advise her during the season of any cards to be sent.

Social: Kathy Turieo sent out a Save the Date for our May 27th Scramble with the 18 Holers. She sent our schedule to Sean at Freeman Grill. Her committee could use a few more members. We can mention at Welcome Back Coffee.

Tournaments/Prizes: Donna Potts indicated that the 2026 schedule has been approved by the Golf Commission. She will send a copy to Susan Sorrento.

The Board discussed removing the Family Tees format from our 2026 Calendar. We will play Team Format on May 14th. Since Marj Oliver has moved to social membership, The Birdie and “under 50” awards will be taken over by the Tournaments/Rules/Prizes committee with collaboration from the Scoring committee. Cindy announced that awardees will be recognized at the Annual Meeting and Holiday Party.

Invitational: Cindy Davey reported for Nancy Purpura and Michelle Litavis. The date has been shared with Sean/Freemans Grill. Nancy asked if the Board would consider approving Golf Status, a company that organized tournaments for the event in September. They charge 5% of income made as fees. With Paulette offering to do the financials, the Board felt Golf Status wasn't needed as our event was not large/complex enough to add value.

Other Business: Cindy Davey reported that there will be a couple of girls from Nauset High School applying for the Golf Scholarship we offer. Cindy has been in contact with the 18 Holers regarding the Scholarship. She asked the Board on behalf of Cheryl Villandry if we can consider holding a tournament including our social members. Finally, Cindy shared Thank You's Captain's pros for holiday gifts from the 9 Holers.
