Entries: Submit rosters no later than noon, Wednesday October 4th via MileSplit at wi.milesplit.com. You can contact Prime Time Timing with any entry questions. Entry fee to Tomahawk High School is \$175.

Tents: Place next to trees behind the finish chute in designated location on Google Earth map.

Buses: Buses may drop off teams in the north Inshalla parking lot. Buses then must park at Qualheim's True Value 79 Hometown Dr, Tomahawk, WI 54487. Try to park in the back parking lot and then in western portion of the front parking lot.

Medical: Our Athletic Trainer, Jim, from Aspirus Health Care, will be on-site. A Tomahawk City Ambulance will be on standby near this location. Do not contact them unless it's an emergency. Use our athletic trainer. Anyone using the ambulance will receive a bill from the City of Tomahawk.

Food: Concessions may be available near the clubhouse, not guaranteed.

Bathrooms: Two on-site porta potties will be available for use.

Reminders: Prior to the meet stop by the pttiming vehicle at the course and check your entries on the entry sheets and pick up chips/bibs that each athlete will wear— it is critical that each athlete wear the chip/bib that they are assigned, do not allow athletes to switch chips/bibs.

Entry limits will be seven runners per varsity team. However, a school may enter an unlimited number of junior varsity runners.

Race results will be announced at the awards ceremony. If you need to leave prior to the end of the meet, the results will be available on-line at www.pttiming.com shortly after the completion of the meet. No faxes will be sent.

A volunteer will be there to greet you when you arrive with meet day guidelines.

It is very important that you follow those guidelines to insure our continued use of this fine facility. Please communicate the following items to your athletes/parents prior to the meet:

- Spectators will be directed to park in the driving range by parking attendants. Overflow parking will be directed by the lot attendant. Absolutely no parking on Clear Lake Road.
- Do not walk on any greens or tees.
- Dogs/pets are not allowed.
- Please have your athletes pick up their team areas after the completion of the meet.
- There will be a 50/50 Raffle at the meet, with 50% to the winner and the other 50% to THS Cross Country for our end of season awards.
