Course

Inspection: The course will be set and ready to be walked at 9:00 A.M. **Should there be frost on Saturday morning; the golf course management may delay walking the course.** This will be announced when you arrive. Please have runners **off** the course by 10:45 A.M., or fifteen minutes prior to the start of the Girls Division II race.

Course: 5000 meters
Run at the Skyline Golf Course. Spikes can be worn; the course is mostly on grass. The course will be marked with appropriate flags and **also** a white line. It is a fair, challenging, and a true cross country course that includes rolling hills, flats, and great scenery!! Course maps will be in your packets when you arrive. Starting lane assignments are randomly assigned by the WIAA.

Tents/Team

Camps: All team camps and tents should be set to the east of the starting area and south of the main golf course parking lot. Be sure to clean up team camps after the meet. Garbage bags will be provided in team packets.

Bus Parking: **Bus parking will be at Marks Little League Field** which is located two blocks east of the golf course. Buses may pull up on 11th Street and Golf Rd to unload, they will be directed to the parking area by the attendant. Buses may pull up to load after the meet to go to the high school athletic field for the awards ceremony.

Restrooms

& Showers: Portable toilets will be available at the Skyline Golf Course near the starting area. **Athletes are asked not to loiter or warm-up in the Skyline Clubhouse.** If you would like shower facilities after the meet, **please call** the Black River Falls High School before meet day and inform us of this. They would be opened for your teams use. (Call Andy Osegard, AD – andy.osegard@brf.org or (715) 284-4324/Ext. #2221 **Please remind athletes and spectators to be considerate and respectful of all golf course properties.**

WIAA Rule: **Wireless communication devices (headsets, radios, cellular phones, etc.) except for the official equipment used by Meet Management and meet officials are illegal.**

Toys: Please instruct teams to not bring footballs, frizzbees, soccer balls, etc. to the meet site. They are to be left in the bus, and not be thrown anywhere before, during, or after the races at the meet site. **Pets, are not allowed at the meet site or on the Skyline Golf Course property. Please relay this information to parents/spectators as you see necessary.**

Restricted

Areas: Restricted areas where only competing athletes and working meet personnel will be allowed are designated by ropes or fences. No spectators or non-participating athletes will be allowed in the starting area at any time, coaches only. The finish area is restricted at all times during and after the races to everyone except working meet personnel. No coaches, spectators, non-participating athletes, student managers, are allowed in these areas. These areas will be roped or fenced.

Teams: Teams will consist of a minimum of 5 runners and a maximum of 7 runners. Those schools running with less than 5 individuals will not be eligible for the team competition, but will compete as individuals.

Entries: **Entries MUST be completed online at pttiming.com by Tuesday, October 18th at 11:59 p.m. Include participants first and last names and GRADE IN SCHOOL when entering.** If you know of team changes during the week of the race, please e-mail me at steve.markee@brf.org. Coaches may change runners up to the start of the race, however, these changes **must** be reported to the meet manager. Please report to the finish area upon arrival to make any changes and to check to see that rosters are correct.

Uniforms: All uniforms must conform with WIAA regulations. Please review these regulations in the information that you received from the WIAA. Be sure to review all uniform regulations with your teams prior to the race.

Scoring: Runners will also wear running numbers on the **front** of their jersey. PT Timing will be scoring the meet using their chip timing system.

Results: Score sheets and results will be tabulated and available as soon as possible after the conclusion of the awards ceremony. Results will also be emailed to coaches and will be available on the WIAA website. Coaches and spectators are asked to be patient as scoring and tabulating is taking place. **Extra time and precautions will be taken to make sure that all results are accurate and correct.**

Awards

Ceremony: The awards ceremony will take place on the Black River Falls High School Track/Football complex starting at 1:00 p.m. Restroom facilities will be available at the awards area.

T-SHIRTS: As has become a tradition with Cross Country runners, souvenir T-Shirts will be available. The shirts are again very unique and special, made ONLY for the Black River Falls Division II Sectional Meet. Cost will be \$12 for short sleeve and \$16.00 for long sleeve. Please pre-order shirts, it makes things less hectic for kids on the day of the race. We will have a very limited supply of shirts for sale at the race, so please pre-order.

Concessions: We will have light concessions available for a free will donation.

Admission Spectators will be charged admission to this WIAA event; \$4.00 adults and students. Please inform those that will be attending, especially parents, that admission will be charged. This helps to defray some of the expenses of hosting this meet. Thank you for your cooperation.

Post Meet: If parents/fans are looking for a great place to eat after the awards ceremony the Skyline Golf Course serves a very fine sandwich menu and at very reasonable prices. The scenery from the dining area at the Skyline is second to none!!! Black River Falls also has many fast food restaurants and sit down restaurants located near both of the I-94 interchanges for teams that will be looking to eat after the awards ceremony before returning home.
