Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. Ten days after Jesus ascended into heaven, He and the Father sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Church. Upon receiving the Holy Spirit, the Apostles were given the gift of preaching to all nations of different languages, because this is the desire of the Holy Spirit: that all might live in union with Christ and receive the grace and mercy of Jesus Christ.

We have a tendency to scatter, but the Holy Spirit unites. One of the most profound ways our union is strengthened and expressed is through the holy Eucharist at Mass, which is possible by the power of the Holy Spirit. How beautiful it is when we are together in the Lord. Sunday, June 22nd, is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, when we celebrate the presence of the Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. I would like to invite you to a special Mass and procession that day. Bishop Spies will celebrate a bilingual Mass at noon on Sunday, June 22nd, and then we will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the Chapel of St. Rose of Lima. Because of the Mass and procession, like last year, there will not be Mass at 11:30 or 1:00 on Sunday the 22nd. I hope that you will be able to join us and Bishop Spies as we give honor to our Lord, present in the Eucharist, the sacrament of charity and unity.

Our Lord loves us and is always at work in us and among us. Let us give God thanks and continue to pray for one another.

Sr. Sarah from the Philippines is coming July 5-6 to all Masses!

She is a member of the Oikos Sisters, a small community of nuns who have dedicated their lives to serving the poor. *One of your very own parishioners, Steve Kelly missioned with the Oikos Sisters last year!*

The Sisters minister to those living in very poor barrios (villages) in distant outlying areas, many that have been devastated by the typhoons that visit their regions frequently. They have an education sponsorship program, a garden project enabling families to grow their own food, a dental clinic and a charity pharmacy providing free medicine (the only one in their area) to name just a few.

This year 'Pilgrims of Hope' is the theme for Jubilee Year 2025 named by Pope Francis. Sr. Sarah will tell us heartwarming stories full of hope about the people the Oikos Sisters serve.

It amazes us all how these eight Sisters and two novices are able to serve so many and doing it **all** on donations. Their lives are not easy ones but they are filled with joy as they are committed to do God's work and care for whomever comes to their door in need.

Las Hermanas atienden a los que viven en barrios (aldeas) marginados, muchas de las cuales han sido devastadas por los tifones frecuentemente. Tienen un programa de patrocinio educativo, un proyecto de huertos que permite a las familias cultivar sus propios alimentos, una clínica dental y una farmacia benéfica que suministra medicamentos gratuitos (la única de la zona), por nombrar sólo algunos.

Este año, "Peregrinos de Esperanza" es el lema del Año Jubilar 2025 proclamado por el Papa Francisco. La Hna. Sarah nos contará historias conmovedoras y llenas de Esperanza sobre las personas a las que ellas sirven.

A todos nos sorprende cómo estas ocho hermanas y dos novicias son capaces de servir a tantas personas y hacerlo todo con donaciones. Sus vidas no son fáciles, pero están llenas de alegría, ya que están comprometidas a hacer el trabajo de Dios y a cuidar de quienquiera necesitado que llegue a su puerta.
