A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁBROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Next Sunday, we will celebrate our Lord's Ascension into heaven, which we profess every Sunday during the Creed. On the fortieth day after Easter, Jesus ascended into Heaven. Then, during the nine days that followed, the Apostles prepared to receive the Holy Spirit. This was the first novena (traditional nine days of prayer). On the fiftieth day after Easter, after seven weeks had passed (a week of weeks), the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, uniting us to Christ and giving the Church the grace and power to continue the work of Christ so that the whole world may be renewed and recreated and made one in Christ. Let us keep our eyes fixed on the Heavenly Lord as He sends us out to live out and proclaim the faith. We are reminded in one of the prefaces of the Ascension that Jesus "ascended, not to distance himself from our lowly state but that we, his members, might be confident of following where he, our Head and Founder has gone before." We remember that the Holy Spirit unites us to Jesus and has been given to us through the Church. With faith, hope, and charity, we are called to follow our Lord to heaven, and this calling impacts the way we approach our daily lives. Let us strive to live in friendship with our Lord. As we prepare to celebrate Pentecost in two weeks, I would like to encourage all of us to pray "Come, Holy Spirit" throughout the week prior to Pentecost, inviting the Holy Spirit into our lives, friendships, workplaces, parish, and homes: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and You shall renew the face of the earth. O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

This Memorial Day weekend, we remember and pray for all who have given theirs in service of country. Also, please remember to join us next Sunday for the farewell Masses (9:30 and 1:00) and receptions that will follow the Masses for Fr. John. We are grateful for his presence and ministry here for the past seven years and continue to pray for him as he prepares to be the pastor of St. Mary Immaculate Parish in Plainfield. Know of my prayers for all of you, and please continue to pray for me and for one another.

El próximo domingo celebraremos la Ascensión del Señor a los cielos, que profesamos cada domingo durante el Credo. El 40º día después de Pascua, Jesús subió al Cielo. Durante los nueve días siguientes, los Apóstoles se prepararon para recibir el Espíritu Santo. Esta fue la primera novena

(nueve días de oración). En el 50º día después de la Pascua, cuando pasaron siete semanas (una semana de semanas), el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los apóstoles, uniéndonos a Cristo y otorgando a la Iglesia la gracia y el poder para continuar la obra de Cristo, y para que todo el mundo sea recreado, renovado y uno en Cristo. Mantengamos nuestros ojos fijos en el Señor celestial que nos envía a vivir y a anunciar la fe. Uno de los prefacios de la Ascensión dice que Jesús "no se fue para alejarse de nuestra pequeñez, sino para que pusieramos nuestra confianza en llegar, como miembros tuyos, a Él, nuestra cabeza y principio, nos ha precedido". Recordamos que el Espíritu Santo nos une a Jesús y nos ha sido dado a través de la Iglesia. Con fe, esperanza y caridad, estamos llamados a seguir a nuestro Señor al cielo, y este llamado afecta nuestras vidas diarias. Luchemos por vivir en amistad con nuestro Señor y mientras nos preparamos para celebrar Pentecostés en dos semanas, me gustaría animar a todos a rezar "Ven, Espíritu Santo" durante la semana antes de Pentecostés, invitando al Espíritu Santo a transformar nuestras vidas, amistades, lugares de trabajo, parroquia y hogares: Ven, Espíritu Santo, llena los corazones de tus fieles y enciende en ellos el fuego de tu amor. Envía tu Espíritu y todo será creado, y se renovará la faz de la tierra. Oh Dios, que aleccionaste los corazones de tus fieles con la ciencia del Espíritu Santo, haz que, guiados por ese mismo Espíritu, saboreemos la dulzura del bien y gocemos siempre de tus divinos consuelos. Por Jesucristo, nuestro Señor. Amén.

Además, les pido que nos acompañen el próximo domingo en las misas de despedida del Padre John (9:30 y 1:00) y a los convivios que seguirán a las misas. Agradecemos su presencia y ministerio aquí durante los últimos siete años y seguimos orando por él mientras se prepara para ser párroco de la Parroquia Santa María Inmaculada en Plainfield. Sepan que rezo por todos ustedes y, por favor, sigan orando por mí y los unos por los otros.




