Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Christ began His public ministry and redeeming work by sanctifying the waters of baptism. Baptism opens for us the door of faith and begins our life with God, pouring forth the Holy Spirit upon us, washing our souls clean from the stain of original sin, uniting us to Christ and making us children of God. What a beautiful gift we receive through Baptism: new life in Christ, eternal life. I am grateful to my parents for bringing me to the church when I was three weeks old to receive such a precious gift. It is important to rediscover, acknowledge, and live according to the profound gift of baptism. We renew our baptism every time we recite the Creed and make the sign of the cross with holy water. The union with God that we receive through baptism is strengthened by Holy Communion and repaired in confession. I hope this following reflection by Pope Benedict XVI on baptism and the objects used in baptism helps you to look into the depth and beauty of your own baptism:

“Then, there are the elements: water, the anointing with oil, the white garment and the flame of the candle. Water is the symbol of life: Baptism is new life in Christ. The oil is the symbol of strength, health and beauty, for it truly is beautiful to live in communion with Christ. Then, there is the white garment, as an expression of the culture of beauty, of the culture of life. And lastly, the flame of the candle is an expression of the truth that shines out in the darkness of history and points out to us who we are, where we come from and where we must go. Dear Godparents, dear parents, dear brothers and sisters, let us thank the Lord today, for God does not hide behind clouds of impenetrable mystery but, as today's Gospel said, has opened the heavens, he has shown himself, he talks to us and is with us; he lives with us and guides us in our lives.” (January 8, 2006)

May we continue to deepen our friendship with Christ, which began in baptism, and may the Lord continue to bless you and your loved ones.

Qué hermoso regalo recibimos a través del bautismo: nueva vida en Cristo, vida eterna! Estoy muy agradecido a mis padres por llevarme a la iglesia cuando yo tenía tres semanas para ser bautizado. Este regalo tan precioso debe ser redescubierto, reconocido y vivido. Renovamos nuestro bautismo cada vez recitamos el Credo y hacemos la señal de la cruz con agua bendita. La unión con Dios que recibimos a través del bautismo es fortalecida con la Sagrada Comunión y es reparada en la confesión. Espero que la siguiente reflexión del Papa Benedicto XVI sobre el bautismo y los objetos utilizados en el bautismo les ayude a conocer la profundidad y la belleza de su propio bautismo:

“Luego están los elementos: el agua, la unción con el óleo, el vestido blanco y la llama de la vela. El agua es símbolo de la vida: el bautismo es vida nueva en Cristo. El óleo es símbolo de la fuerza, de la salud, de la belleza, porque realmente es bello vivir en comunión con Cristo. El vestido blanco es expresión de la cultura de la belleza, de la cultura de la vida. Y, por último, la llama de la vela es expresión de la verdad que resplandece en las oscuridades de la historia y nos indica quiénes somos, de dónde venimos y a dónde debemos ir. Queridos padrinos y madrinas, queridos padres, queridos hermanos, demos gracias hoy al Señor porque Dios no se esconde detrás de las nubes del misterio impenetrable, sino que, como decía el evangelio de hoy, ha abierto los cielos, se nos ha mostrado, habla con nosotros y está con nosotros; vive con nosotros y nos guía en nuestra vida.” (8 enero 2006).

Que sigamos profundizando nuestra amistad con Cristo, que comenzó en el bautismo, y que el Señor siga bendiciéndoles a ustedes y a sus seres queridos.

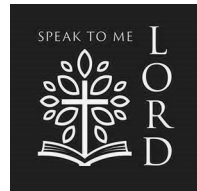

## **POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS**

## **THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH**



Until December 2021, there are many new ways that Catholics can receive an indulgence, including entrusting their daily work to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker or reciting the rosary with their families.

These acts must be accompanied by sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the pope's intentions, the usual conditions to obtain any plenary indulgence.

Plenary indulgences remit all temporal punishment due to sin and must be accompanied by full detachment from sin.

**According to the decree issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary on Dec. 8, there are 15 ways to receive an indulgence in the Year of St. Joseph:**

- 1) Participate in a spiritual retreat for at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph.
- 2) Pray for St. Joseph's intercession for the unemployed that they might find dignifying work.
- 3) Recite the [Litany of St. Joseph](#) for persecuted Christians. Byzantine Catholics have the option of an Akathist to St. Joseph.
- 4) Entrust one's daily work and activity to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker.
- 5) Follow St. Joseph's example in performing a corporal work of mercy. These include feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, visiting the imprisoned, visiting the sick, and burying the dead.
- 6) Perform one of the spiritual works of mercy, such as comforting the sorrowful, counseling the doubtful, instructing the ignorant, admonishing the sinner, bearing wrongs patiently, forgiving injuries, and praying for the living and the dead.
- 7) Pray the rosary together with one's family in order that "all Christian families may be stimulated to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was in the Holy Family."
- 8) Engaged couples can also receive an indulgence from praying the rosary together.
- 9) Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, because St. Joseph "invites us to rediscover our filial relationship with the Father, to renew fidelity to prayer, to listen and correspond with profound discernment to God's will."
- 10) Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on St. Joseph Sunday, the Sunday after Christmas in the Byzantine Catholic tradition.
- 11) Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph on March 19 with an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph.
- 12) Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on the 19th of any month.
- 13) Honor Joseph with an act of piety or approved prayer on a Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to St. Joseph.
- 14) Pray to St. Joseph on the Feast of the Holy Family on Dec. 29.
- 15) Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1 with an act of piety or prayer.

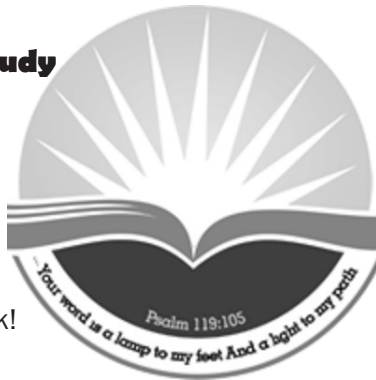

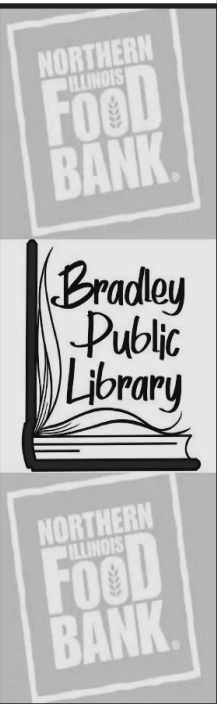

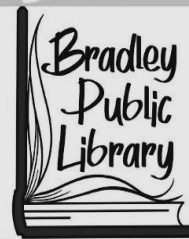
