

AN OPEN LETTER TO DEACON JESUS

Dear Deacon Jesus,

DON'T FORGET THAT YOU ARE GOOD. You have many good qualities that I already appreciate in you, first as a human being, and second as a future priest. Your openness to learn new things, your humility to listen and to ask for guidance, your hunger for knowledge and experience, your relentless sense of humor, your ability to wisely respond to challenging situations, your prayer life and reflective spirituality, your special talents, your sense of pastoral compassion displayed in our visits to the sick and those who need listening ears. Never ever forget that you are good, and God has given you many gifts that God will use for your future. But beside all your good gifts and qualities, never forget that true goodness lies deep within you.

YOUR DEACONATE IS A FOUNDATION OF YOUR FUTURE PRIESTHOOD. You are a transitional deacon for about a year, and so this time of your life is quite special. This year tells you that the foundation of your future priesthood is to serve God and His Church. Your willingness to serve during your two months here in our parish is a sure mark of the authentic server that you will become. So don't spare yourself from any opportunity to serve, in both big and small ways, even when sometimes, it is hard or inconvenient. That is your way of life, now and for the rest of your life. Your service will define you and give you purpose. Thank God every day for the opportunity to serve Him and the people He brings to your care. Serve with compassion and joy, serve with the love of Jesus, serve without reservation. It will make your life more meaningful!

YOU WILL NEVER BE WORTHY, BUT BE HUMBLE ENOUGH TO ACCEPT THE LOVE OF GOD AND HIS PEOPLE. No one is worthy, but this is not about who is worthy, as it is about who is humble enough to say yes, anyway. Say YES, despite the feelings of limitation, unworthiness, inhibitions, and doubts. There is no final clarity and assurance. There is only your humble trust in God that He will use you well in spite of yourself. Together with your self-giving, God will be generous to you, by bringing people into your life, who will become part of your spiritual family, and will be there to support your vocation. They will be there for you, because of their love of God, and they see God working in and through you. Accept their love humbly, in the name of God. Wherever you go to serve the Lord, God will bring people to love you and support you. Know how to accept these gifts, and say thank you to God who is never outdone in generosity.

These days, when we are concerned about the future of the Church and how we can have priests to serve the people of God, it is quite refreshing to have a chance to get to know such an excellent person like you. It gives us hope about the future, and assures us that God continues to call good men to His vineyard. Thank you, Deacon Jesus, for giving us a glimpse of the amazing priest that you will become in the future. As you go, we will continue to pray for you, and know that you will always have a home in Kankakee. For people like you and me, whose home is away from here, I understand the sacrifice of being away from family. But know that God will always be there for you, and now, I am too. Know that I, and our parish, will always be here for you! See you again!




