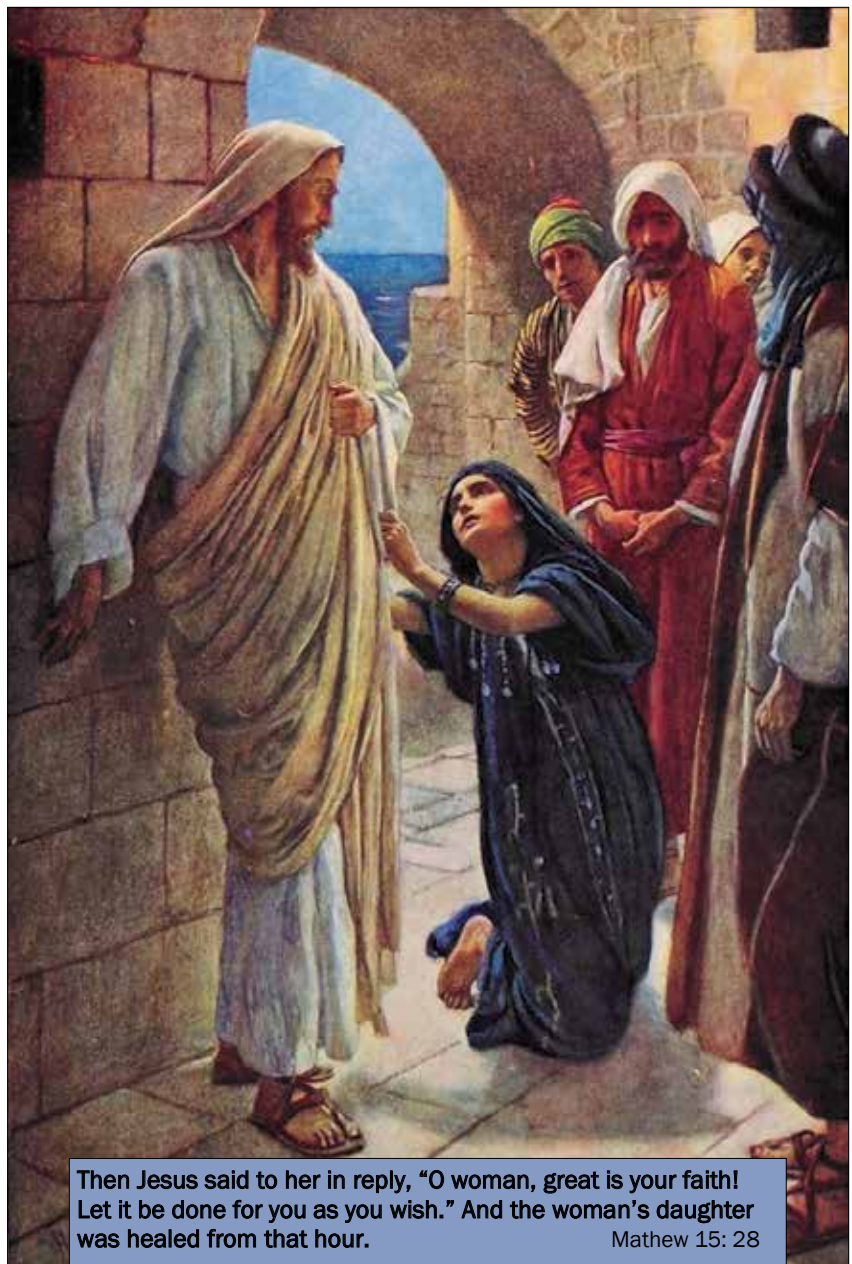

A LITTLE HOMAGE TO GREAT WOMEN IN OUR CHURCH

Throughout the history of the church, in Her grand history, but also in the local history of the Church here in Kankakee, we can find many stories of some great women of faith that have graced our community through the years. These women do great things for the Church community every moment of every day, yet for the most part they remain unnoticed, and underappreciated. This weekend, I want to put under a special spotlight of gratitude and honor two of these many women here, on behalf of the many that form part of their ranks.

SR. MARY FRANCIS MACISAAC, CND. If anyone has ever noticed a little nun with a permanent smirk and a smile on her face, walking carefully to the Azzarelli Clinic, or visiting a home, or going to the both Spanish masses in the weekend, I bet you have seen Sr. Mary Francis. I want to officially say that I want to have Sr. Mary's attitude when I myself get to be 90. Her sense of humor is infectious, she might introduce herself as half-Scotch and half-Soda, and will warn you to not ask her if the Sodas are also Europeans. This weekend we celebrate Sr. Mary's 70 years anniversary since her first profession in the convent, as part of the Sisters of Notre Dame. When asked about this celebration, she would say, "This is not the silver or golden jubilee anniversary... but the jubilee of grace, because it is only by the grace of God that I can still celebrate it." Sitting down with her to reminisce the years of teaching and some very adventurous assignments she has had over the years, including being in Guatemala to instantly take the role of a nurse, I couldn't help but be moved by the many things that God has accomplished through her. She practically built a school, put up a clinic and spent years teaching in Kankakee, and in Chicagoland, as well as in New York.

SR. LINDA HATTON, SSCM. The Sisters of the Holy Heart of Mary has been blessed by the leadership and vision of a nun whose humility and practical outlook in life has blessed not only her congregation but also the larger community here in the Kankakee area. For ten years, she provided leadership for her congregation, networked with so many leaders in the community, and consistently worked for the spiritual and physical growth of her congregation. That new office facility at One Heart, One Soul is just one of the concrete signs of the leadership of Sr. Linda, but for me, what I will always be grateful to Sr. Linda is her utmost support and encouragement to my own ministry as a priest. We have spent so many special moments after morning masses over the years just encouraging each other to stay in the course, and try to live a balanced life in the midst of our very demanding roles in the Church. As she passes on the responsibility of being the Provincial Superior of her community, I want to take this time to thank her for all her goodness, generosity, support and spiritual leadership, and wish her the best of time as she enters a new phase in her religious life.

May God continue to bless these two great women in our church and may they know always our deepest respect and appreciation for them! Ad multos annos, Sisters!

HNA. MARY FRANCIS MACISAAC, CND. Si alguien se ha dado cuenta y ha visto a una monjita con una sonrisa permanente, entrando con cuidado a la Clínica Azzarelli, o visitando a una familia, o yendo a las dos misas en español en fin de semana, estoy seguro que han visto a la Hna. Mary Francis. Quiero oficialmente decirles que yo quiero tener la actitud de Hna. Mary cuando yo tenga mis 90 años. Su sentido de humor es contagioso, ella se introduce cómo mitad-Scotch y mitad-Soday te advierte el no preguntarle si las Sodas son también Europeas. Este fin de semana celebramos los 70 años de aniversario desde que ella hizo su primera profesión en el convento de las Hermanas de Norte Dame. Cuando se le pregunta sobre esta celebración, ella dice, "Esta no es el jubileo de plata o de oro...pero el jubileo de gracia, porque es solo por gracia de Dios que todavía puedo celebrarlo." Sentado con ella recordando sus años como maestra y algunas asignaciones venturosas que ella ha vivido a través de los años, incluyendo su estancia en Guatemala donde instantáneamente tomó el rol de enfermera, no pude mas que sentirme conmovido por las muchas cosas que Dios ha obrado a través de ella. HNA. LINDA HATTON, SSCM. 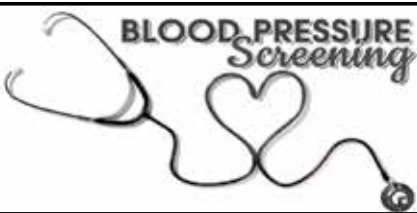
