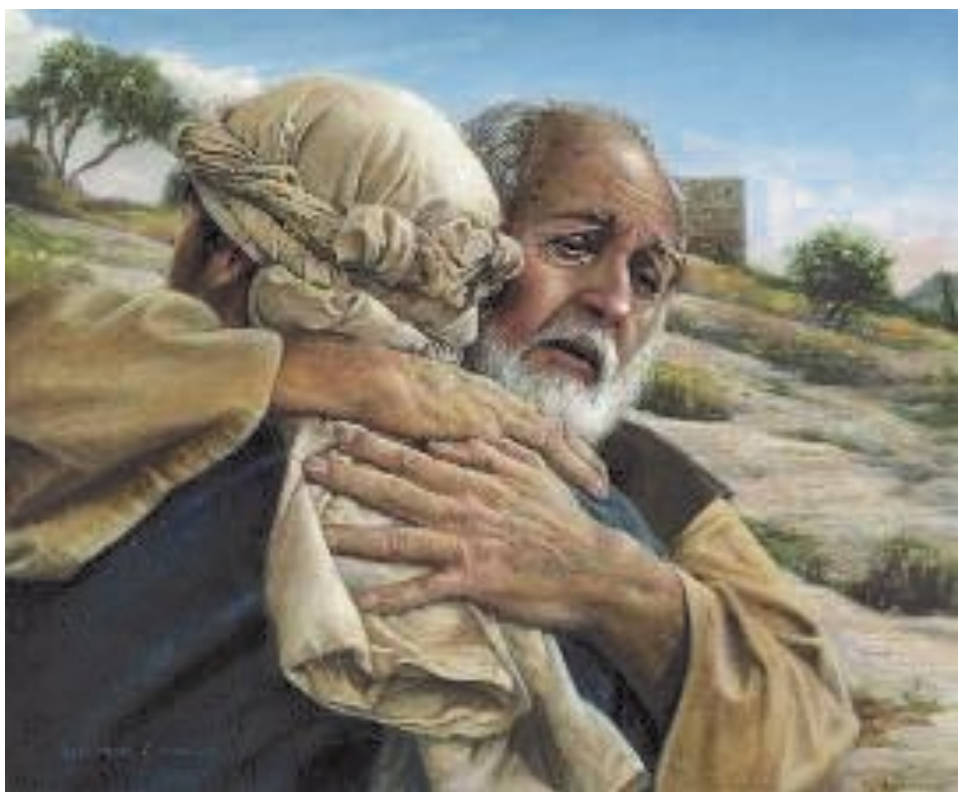

## THE POWER OF INVITATION

The movement of Christianity started with one simple invitation: "Come, follow me..." were the words that Jesus used to invite the first apostles by the Sea of Galilee. From those first words of invitation, many others followed. At another time, he said to the disciples of John the Baptist: "Come and see..." and they too followed Him. The consistent encounters, village after village, one person after another, crowd after another crowd, led to the growth of his following. And that was a time without twitter, facebook and instagram! It was just pure invitation, by His words, by His miraculous works, by His Divine Presence.

Well, here in Kankakee, many centuries later, we continue to proclaim His word, He continues to do miraculous work through the sacraments, and we are still coming together to encounter Him again. And what we ought to be doing really, in our own time, is to invite, just like He did, one person at a time, one crowd at a time, one village at a time. One of my friends used to poke some friendly jest at me because I was always shy asking a favor or putting out invitations to strangers for any affair. In other words, I was not really wired to be a salesman, while my friend was a well decorated and multi-awarded salesperson in her company. She told me that her success as a salesperson was based on three things:

Be honest at all times. Share the positive, good news as much as you can.

Don't be afraid to ask or to request. All they can say is No. But if you never asked, then you would never know for sure, if it is a sale that you could have had.

But then, never take No for an answer. If they say No the first time, find other ways to re-introduce and re-invite, and sell again in a different way.

I am still not a born salesperson, but whenever I think of these three things that my friend told me, I come to realize that they are not really that hard to do. Everyone can be a salesperson, in this regard. Allow me to adapt my friend's three first principles in sales, in the light of our need to invite and evangelize in our time, as a Church:

Be a sincere witness. Talk about the good things that are going on at Church, and share the positive effects of your Church to you. Deep within, everyone is looking for something good for their lives, and who knows, your random testimony might strike a chord for someone to go with you to church.

Don't be afraid to invite. You have a Sunday family gathering, and most of your family have fallen away from the Church. What do you do? Invite everyone to go to Church with you. You never know who will say yes, and the only thing they can do is to say no. There is no harm in inviting!

Never give up. Sometimes, hearing "no" over and over again, for every invitation, can be disheartening. Take it as a challenge in creativity, instead. Find new ways to share your faith to the people around you. Wear a shirt that says "Are you happy? I found my happiness in being with God and His peeps." Or re-echo St. Augustine's words in your facebook update: "My heart is restless until it rests in You, my God." Thinking of creative ways to spread the Good News can be fun and exciting. Try it!

From Jesus; first invitation to our efforts to invite today, know that you are doing holy work. Here in St. John Paul II Parish, we will continue to invite, because we are confident about the quality of our goods. There is power in invitation, because Jesus is inviting with us. Peace... hope... love... everlasting life... anyone?

## EL PODER DE LA INVITACIÓN

El movimiento de la Cristiandad comenzó con una simple invitación: "Ven, sígueme..." fueron las palabras de Jesús cuando invitó a sus primeros apóstoles a la orilla del mar de Galilea. Desde esas primeras palabras de invitación, muchos otros lo siguieron. Después, él dijo a los discípulos de Juan Bautista: "Vengan y vean..." y ellos también lo siguieron. Los encuentros consistentes, pueblo tras pueblo, una persona y otra, grupo tras grupo, aumentó el crecimiento de sus seguidores. Y ese era el tiempo sin twitter, facebook e instagram! Era simplemente pura invitación, por medio de Su palabra, Sus milagros, y por Su Divina Presencia.

Bueno, aquí en Kankakee, muchos siglos después, continuamos proclamando Su palabra. Él continúa haciendo milagros por medio de los sacramentos, y nosotros seguimos reuniéndonos para encontrarlo a Él nuevamente. Y lo que debemos hacer hoy día es seguir Su ejemplo e invitar una persona y después otra, un grupo y después otro, un pueblo y después otro. Una amiga me hacía broma porque yo era tímido al invitar desconocidos a cualquier acontecimiento o a pedirles un favor. En otras palabras, yo no tenía el don de ser comerciante como mi amiga lo era en su negocio. Ella me dijo que el éxito de un vendedor está basado en tres cosas:

1. Ser sincero en todo tiempo. Compartir lo positivo, dar buenas noticias tanto como sea posible.

2. No tener temor en hacer preguntas o en hacer un pedido. Ellos pueden decir NO. Pero si nunca preguntas, entonces no habría seguridad, si era una venta que tu podrías llevar a cabo.

3. Pero, nunca aceptes el NO como respuesta. Si dicen NO la primer vez, busca otras maneras de re-introducirlo y re-invitar, y presentarlo en una manera diferente.

Todavía no soy vendedor, pero cuando pienso en estas tres cosas que me dijo mi amiga, realizo que no son tan difíciles en hacer. Todos pueden ser vendedores, en este sentido. Permítanme adaptar estas tres cosas que me dijo mi amiga, y como en realidad no son difíciles en aplicarlas a la evangelización en nuestros tiempos, como Iglesia que somos:

1. Ser un testigo sincero. Hablar de cosas buenas que están pasando en la Iglesia, y compartir cómo me afectan personalmente. En lo íntimo, todos están en búsqueda de algo bueno para sus vidas, pero quizá tu testimonio toque a alguna persona y vaya contigo a la iglesia.

2. No temas en invitar. Puedes invitar a la familia a la reunión Dominical, y quizá toda tu familia esta retirada de la Iglesia. ¿Qué puedes hacer? Invita a todos a ir a la Iglesia contigo. Nunca sabes quién va a decir sí, y lo único que pueden decir es no. ¡No hay peligro en invitar!

3. Nunca te sientas rendido. Algunas veces, después de oír "no" muchas veces, eso te puede causar desánimo. En cambio, tómallo como un reto en creatividad. Busca nuevas maneras en compartir tu fe con la gente a tu alrededor. Usa una camiseta que dice "¿Te sientes feliz? Encontré mi felicidad en estar con Dios y Sus pequeños." O eco lo que dice San Agustín: "Mi corazón está inquieto hasta que descansa en Tí, mi Dios." Pensando en maneras creativas en propagar las Buenas Nuevas puede ser divertido y excitante. ¡Ensáyalo!

De Jesús; la primera invitación a nuestros esfuerzos para invitar hoy, has de saber que estoy haciendo un trabajo santo. Aquí en la parroquia San Juan Pablo II, continuaremos en invitar, porque tenemos la confianza en la calidad de nuestros ofrecimientos. Hay poder al invitar, porque Jesús esta invitando con nosotros. Paz... esperanza... amor... vida eterna... ¿hay alguien?

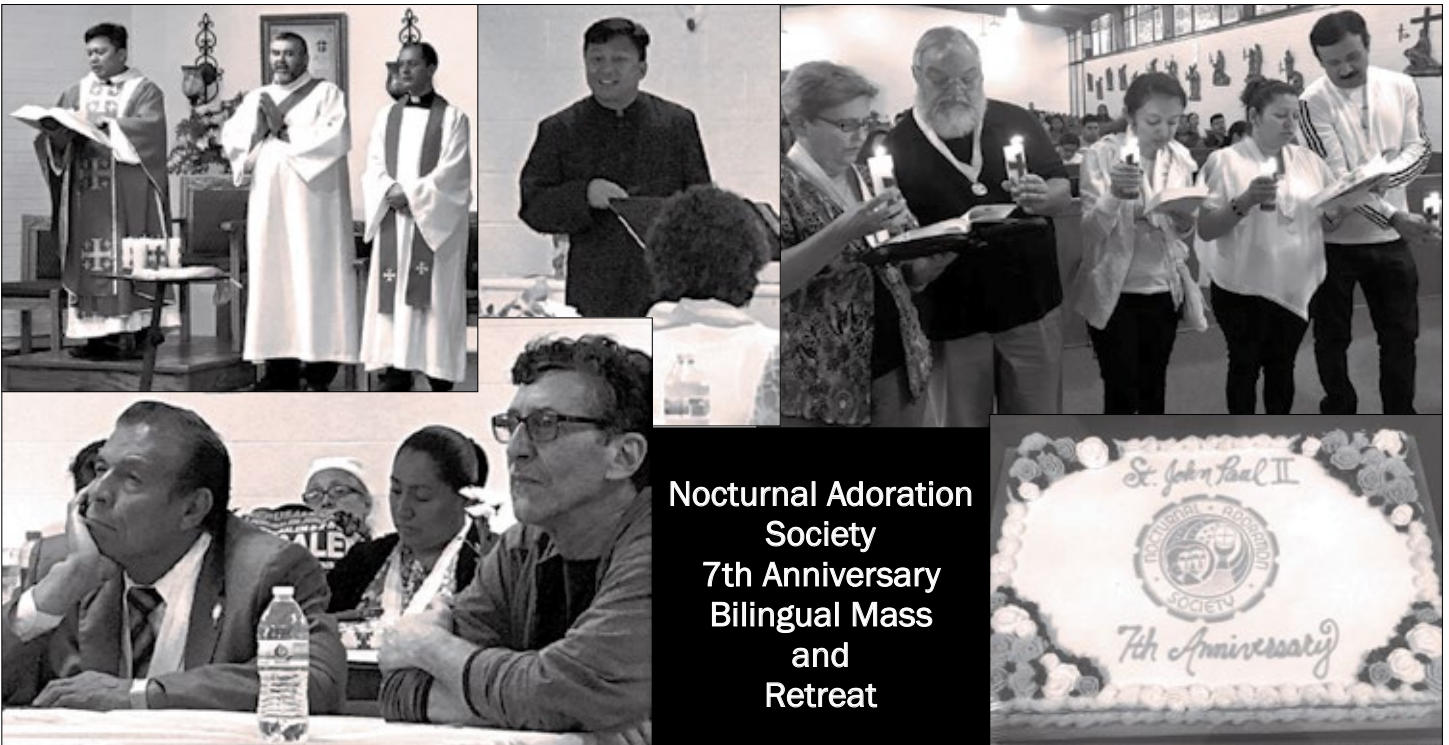

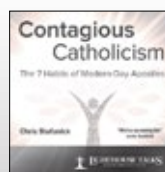
