**A MINISTRY FAIR AND PARISH
OPEN HOUSE:
IMAGINE A DYNAMIC CHURCH...
IF WE ALL PARTICIPATE!**

Since July 1, when we officially founded our St. John Paul II Parish, we have tirelessly looked for ways to establish its operation and life. Since that evening when the Tri-Parish leadership Team unanimously agreed to the idea of centralization of the parish, I have been counting the blessings, both known and disguised, and discovered that Divine Providence has been preparing for the centralization before we even knew it.

For example, just a couple of years ago, the multipurpose hall of St. Martin School was flooded, and it forced people to think of what to do with it. Through the creative minds of Brian Haller and his team of friends and volunteers, we now have what we call the Family Center, which has been very useful for the life of JPII Parish. An even more poignant example is that of the Junior High wing of the school. Fr. Tom Paul, who has been involved in the building projects of the diocese for over thirty years, came to visit me last week, and told me that when Fr. Settles proposed the building of the Junior High wing, the diocesan office doubted whether it was necessary, but they went along with it. So I told him that if they ever doubted then, they shouldn't doubt it now, because the new Junior High Wing in the school building is now being designed to become the parish office, therefore centralizing our office space to be in the same building as the faith formation, evangelization and liturgical offices. God's Providence was already way ahead of us, so that even a flood and a permissive decision of the building consultants in Joliet were going to benefit the life of the parish today.

I hope that as you visit the facilities of our West Campus, you all can recognize the many possibilities of this location for the use of a vibrant and multi-faceted parish that we are all moving to become. Consider even the verdant environment surrounding this campus, including the trails under the trees in the northern side. Imagine the youth and the children running around in the open field. Imagine rosary groups praying by a grotto under the trees, imagine our youth group grilling by the rectory. Imagine a church full of people after mass, going to fellowship, as we do now at the family center, and maybe later, at an outdoor patio café next to the church. Imagine being able to walk to the church, the parish office, and the faith formation building just a stone's throw away from each other. Imagine the church building and the facilities of the church full of activities in the evening, from Bible Study, to Hispanic renewal groups, to parish meetings, and maybe a devotional group in church. Imagine a vibrant church where parishioners do not only attend mass on Sundays, but participate in the life of the Church, through mission and evangelization. Imagine the environment that our children will grow with, and the faith that would develop through them. THIS IS MY DREAM AS YOUR PASTOR, and I am sure this is WHAT GOD WANTS of us.

This is what this weekend's open house and ministry fair is trying to do. To wake us up to desire something even better than the Church that we are today, by growing in commitment to serve and love the Lord, in His Church. God bless JPII Parish!

Desde Julio 1, cuando oficialmente se realizó la parroquia Juan Pablo II, hemos trabajado incansablemente para establecer su vida y operación. Desde esa tarde cuando los equipos de las tres parroquias convinieron en centralizarlas en una parroquia, yo he contado las bendiciones, claras y no tan claras, y descubrí que la Divina Providencia nos ha estado preparando esta centralización, nosotros sin saberlo.

Por ejemplo, hace dos años, el salón de diversas actividades de la escuela San Martín estaba inundada, y la gente forzosamente tenía que resolver la situación. Por medio de la creatividad de Brian Haller y sus amigos y voluntarios, hoy día tenemos el Centro Familia, que muy bien utilizamos para la vida parroquial de JPII. Un ejemplo más resaltante es el ala de los grados 7 y 8. El Padre Tom Paul, indicado por la diócesis para proyectos en levantar edificios por mas de treinta años, vino recién a visitarme, y me dijo que el Padre Settles había propuesto la finca del edificio, pero que dudaba fuera necesario, pero no obstante eso, se realizó. Así es que yo le dije, si antes había duda, hoy no lo hay, porque ese espacio se está convirtiendo en oficina parroquial, centralizando este espacio en el mismo edificio de la formación de fe, evangelización y oficinas para la liturgia. La Providencia de Dios ya se adelantaba trabajando para el beneficio de todos, nosotros y los consultantes de Joliet. Todo iba para el beneficio de la vida de la parroquia de hoy día.

Espero que ustedes al visitar aquí, puedan ver las muchas posibilidades que esta localidad ofrece para un uso a una vibrante y multi-beneficiosa parroquia a la cual nos dirigimos. Consideren simplemente el verde campo que nos rodea, incluyendo las veredas bajo los árboles hacia el norte. Imagínense ver a los jóvenes y a los niños corriendo alrededor a campo libre. Imagínense grupos rezando el rosario en una gruta bajo los árboles, imaginéndose a un grupo juvenil asando en una parrilla cerca de la rectoría. Imagínense a una iglesia llena de gente que después de misa se reúne a convivir, como lo hacemos ahora en el centro familia, y quizás después, en un patio afuera enseguida de la iglesia tomando café. Imagínense poder caminar a la iglesia, a la oficina parroquial, y al edificio de formación de fe tan cerca como el tirar una piedra. Imagínense el edificio de la iglesia y sus facilidades llenas de actividades por la tarde, desde estudio de Biblia, a grupos hispanos de renovación, a juntas parroquiales, y quizás un grupo devocional en la iglesia. Imagínense una iglesia vibrante donde feligreses no solo vienen a misa los domingos, pero también participan en la vida de la Iglesia, por medio de misión y evangelización. Imagínense un ambiente en el cual nuestros niños irán creciendo juntamente con su fe. ESTE ES MI SUEÑO COMO SU PASTOR, y estoy seguro que esto es LO QUE DIOS QUIERE de nosotros.

Esto es lo que se trata de hacer en la exhibición de ministerios este fin de semana. A despertarnos a desear algo, todavía mejor, de cómo somos Iglesia hoy, para crecer en compromiso a servir y amar al Señor, en Su Iglesia. ¡Que Dios bendiga a la Parroquia JPII!




