## OUR FIRST PATRONAL FEAST DAY

Happy feast day, JP2 Parish!

This is our first patronal feast day, since St. John Paul II's official feast day in the Roman Catholic liturgical calendar is October 22. This choice of our patron's feast day is not very typical, because usually a saint's feast is "dies natalis" – the day of death, when the saint enters into heaven. If this norm was followed, his feast day should have been April 2, a date which would most likely fall on a Holy Week. To guarantee that the feast of St. John Paul II would be celebrated solemnly every year, the Vatican has decided to choose the anniversary of his pontifical inauguration. He was elected pope on October 16, 1978, and a few days later, his solemn inauguration as pope of the Church was on October 22, 1978.

It is quite special that the actual date falls on a Sunday this year, so that as a parish, we can celebrate it together for the first time in our weekend masses and liturgies. Our feast day celebration this year is simple, and I know it will still continue to grow into something big and awesome in the years to come. But more important than the entertainment and food, this weekend, I really do feel blessed that we are here together as a church, that we have arrived together as a community here. This is truly something to celebrate, that in just eight months since the day that Bishop Conlon announced the changes here in Kankakee, we are here today, and we are positively growing as a parish, and the culture that we are growing here is being realized steadily. In such a short time, we have accomplished so much as a faith community!

As I look into the examples of Saint John Paul II, I am most inspired by his love for people. I look at videos and images of him kissing and hugging children, how he attracted them, how they would just naturally be drawn to him. Children from everywhere around the world have been touched by this pope, children who are now in their 30's and 40's, children who are now having children too, perhaps some have become themselves priests or nuns who are now taking care of children. The image of John Paul II's love for people also shines through in his relationship with the youth. Having started the movement of World Youth Day, our patron was passionate about reaching out to the young people. He had such a special charisma that allowed him to be relevant to the young people. They listened to what he had to say. They swarmed around him. They cheered his name. They loved him, and would cheer it: "JP2, we love you!" and the pope at one time turned and responded, "JP2, he loves you!" everywhere he went during his papacy, he carried with him the flag of Christ and His Church, and as Vicar for Christ, he called people to a relationship with God. He reached out to people of every kind, including the non-Catholics, and non-Christians. He built bridges where people in the fringes of the Christian world would feel comfortable to come forward and stand side-by-side with the followers of Jesus. What an ambassador for Christ our patron saint is, and I am so incredibly inspired by everything he has done.

As we celebrate his feast day for the first time, I invite you, dear parishioners, to get to know our Pope John Paul better. He wrote many encyclicals and messages, he delivered many messages and speeches around the world, and he taught us many great things by his examples. There is much to learn about his example of what we can become as Christians. Happy feast day, JP2! May our patron continue to inspire us, so that we can be the Catholic Church that he can be proud of from heaven. I know he prays for us from there!

## PRIMERA FIESTA DE NUESTRO PATRÓN

¡Feliz día de fiesta, Parroquia JP2!

Esta es nuestra primera fiesta patronal, es la fiesta oficial de San Juan Pablo II en el calendario Católico litúrgico Romano el 22 de Octubre. Generalmente la fiesta de un santo se celebra "dies natalis" – el día de su muerte, cuando el santo entra al cielo. Si esta norma aquí se aplicara, su fiesta sería el 2 de Abril, una fecha que caería en Semana Santa. Para garantizar que la fiesta de Juan Pablo II se celebrara solemnemente cada año, el Vaticano decidió escoger el aniversario de su inauguración pontifical. Él fue elegido papa el 16 de Octubre de 1978, y unos días después, su inauguración solemne como papa de la Iglesia fue el 22 de Octubre de 1978.

Es algo especial que la fecha este año cae en Domingo, entonces como parroquia podemos celebrar juntos por primera vez este fin de semana en nuestras misas y litúrgicas. La fiesta este año es simple, y yo sé que en los años venideros crecerá en algo mas y mas grande y maravilloso. Pero mas importante que el festejo y los alimentos, este fin de semana, yo en realidad siento que somos bendecidos al estar unidos como iglesia, que ya hemos llegado a formar comunidad aquí. Esto en realidad es algo que merece celebración, que ya son ocho meses desde el día que el Obispo Conlon anunció los cambios aquí en Kankakee, estamos aquí hoy, y positivamente vamos creciendo como parroquia, y la cultura que se va desarrollando aquí continúa realizándose. En corto tiempo, ¡hemos efectuado muchísimo como comunidad de fe!

Al considerar los ejemplares de San Juan Pablo II, me siento inspirado por su amor por la gente. Veo videos e imágenes besando y abrazando a los niños, como los atraía, como ellos naturalmente eran atraídos por él. Niños de todo el mundo han sido tocados por este papa, niños que hoy día tienen 30 y 40 años, niños que ahora tienen niños también, quizá algunos ya son sacerdotes o monjas que hoy están a cargo de niños. El amor de Juan Pablo II por la gente brilla a través de su relación con la juventud. Habiendo iniciado el movimiento Mundial del Día de la Juventud, nuestro patrón estaba apasionado por alcanzar y atraer a la juventud. Su carisma tan especial, le permitía tocar el corazón de los jóvenes. Ellos escuchaban todo lo que él decía. La juventud hormigueaba a su alrededor. Ellos con gran alegría pronunciaban su nombre. Ellos con gran amor gritaban: "JP2, te amamos!" y el papa en una ocasión, les respondió, "JP2, él los ama!" Por donde quiera que él anduviera durante su papado, él llevaba la bandera de Cristo y Su Iglesia, y como vicario de Cristo, él invitaba a la gente a vivir una relación íntima con Dios. Él tocaba el corazón de todo tipo de gente, incluyendo a los no-Católicos, y los no-Cristianos. Él edificaba puentes a donde los Cristianos, a las orillas del mundo, se sentirían confortables al venir y estar lado a lado con los seguidores de Jesús. Que embajador por Cristo es nuestro santo patrono, y yo soy increíblemente inspirado por todo lo que él ha hecho.

Al celebrar su día de fiesta por primera vez, los invito, queridos feligreses, a conocer mejor a nuestro Papa Juan Pablo. Él escribió muchas encíclicas y mensajes, él dio muchos discursos por todo el mundo y, por medio de su ejemplo personal, nos enseñó muchas cosas grandiosas. Hay mucho que aprender por su ejemplo, por lo que podemos lograr como Cristianos. ¡Feliz día de fiesta, JP2! Que nuestro patrono continúe inspirándonos, para llegar a ser la Iglesia Católica que sería para él un encanto en el cielo. Yo confío que él reza por nosotros desde allí!
