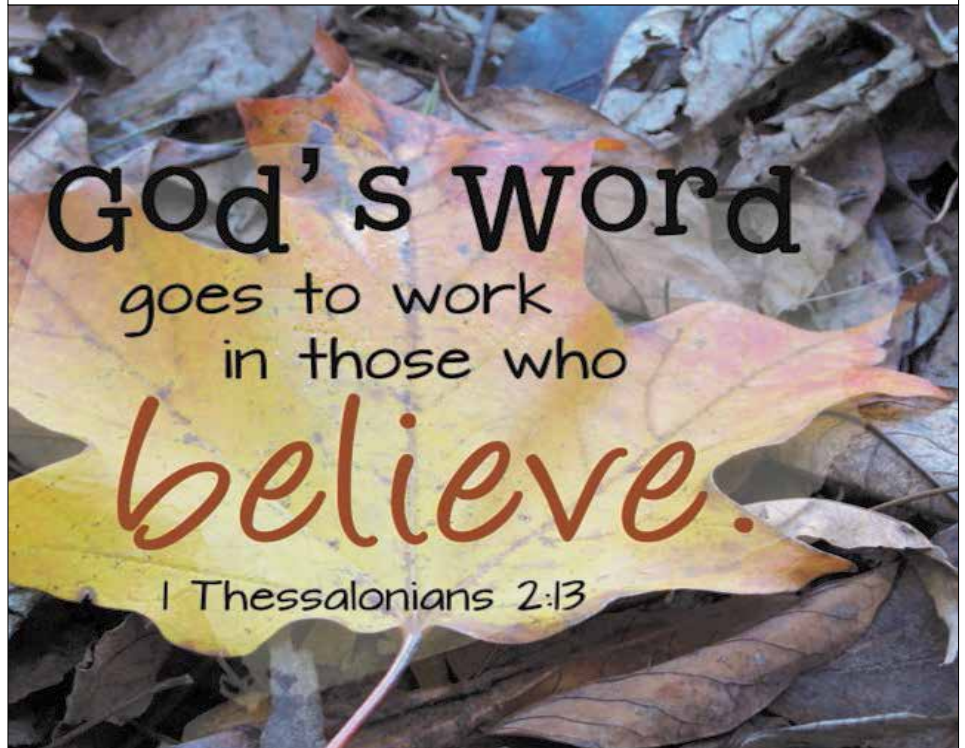

THIS IS NO MUSICAL SHOW

I know some of you may have heard me say this verbally before some of the masses a few weeks ago, but I want to make sure that everyone somehow understands what I am doing, and so for the sake of creative repetition, if not for some, a first-hand information, I want to repeat what I said here in this bulletin: THIS IS NOT A MUSICAL SHOW, but LITURGICAL MUSIC, particularly a prelude, a call to gathering, a form of praying, an invitation to prepare for mass.

So far, we have learned three songs: Welcome to the Family, In Omnibus, and Lord I Lift Your Name on High. These three songs set the mood to our liturgy. They have helped us come together to prepare for celebrating the Eucharist. Each of these songs teach us about what God is doing to our community. Welcome to the Family was an anthem to bring us together into this new parish. In Omnibus was a short teaching about loving and serving God, giving me the opportunity to provide my little reflections about spirituality or ministry. Lord, I Lift Your Name on High is a high energy song that tells us about what Jesus has done from the incarnation to ascension. It is a beautiful summary of the Christological mystery.

In the same manner, I, YOUR PASTOR, AM NOT AUDITIONING FOR AMERICA'S GOT TALENT. I embraced the priesthood several moons ago, and walked out of a promising showbiz career in the Philippines, discerning very clearly that God called me to be a priest. I am not here in the priesthood to flaunt any talent, nor to seek popularity as a singer. That is absolutely ridiculous. But as your priest, I can only bring who I am into my priestly ministry, including my own talents and experiences. And so, for those who are not aware, I do have a strong musical gift, and I grew up singing with my family at mass, at school, and later on in theater and on television. It is who I am, and God called me as I am, so I will never apologize for using my personal gifts in my ministry as a priest. I introduce the songs, and invite the community to sing, because this is what I know, this is my gift, and I am supposed to use it. It is very simple where I am coming from. Singing is part of my spirituality and I want to share it with our parish. We need to realize that singing is praying, and when we sing at church, we have God as our one and only audience. I also want to make sure that it is clear that when I do offer a song at mass, for prayer or reflection, I am not looking for people to clap for me, nor the song, nor the singing, like a program. I actually prefer that we maintain a prayerful silence to those who might need to reflect on what was sung or prayed in music.

This is not a GIMMICK. It is a culture that we want to develop here in our parish. We need to grow to be a singing church, because many of our prayers are sung, from the entrance song to the recessional, and everything else in between. As I said a few weeks ago, I want our parishioners to feel free to express themselves in prayer. When they want to raise their hands, as when the Spirit moves them, they should not feel inhibited to do so. Nothing in the Catholic tradition restricts our movements, but in fact, our gestures and movements during mass reflect the richest and deepest truths of the celebration. In the same manner, I also do not want those who are not disposed to move their hands to feel judged for not participating, either. All I ask is for all of us to be open to how the Holy Spirit moves us to celebrate the mass or to sing the songs, within considerable order and reason.

Finally, I ask you, dear parishioners, to educate one another about this culture and spirituality. Let us help each other bring the culture of song in our parish. Sing your heart out here at JP2!

ESTA NO ES UNA EXHIBICIÓN MUSICAL

Yo se que algunos de ustedes me han oído decir lo siguiente en algunas misas hace unas semanas, pero quiero estar seguro que todos comprendan lo que estoy haciendo, entonces por medio de una repetición creativa y por una información directa, quiero aquí decir lo siguiente: ESTA NO ES UNA EXHIBICIÓN MUSICAL, pero si es MÚSICA LITÚRGICA, particularmente un prelude, una llamada a una reunión, a una forma de rezar, una invitación a prepararnos para la misa.

A esta fecha, hemos aprendido tres cantos: Bienvenidos a la Familia, En Omnibus, y Señor Elevo Tu Nombre a las Alturas. Estos cantos nos han ayudado a reunirnos y prepararnos para celebrar la Eucaristía. Cada canto nos enseña lo que Dios esta obrando en nuestra comunidad. Bienvenidos a la Familia, fue un canto diseñado a traernos juntos a esta nueva parroquia. En Omnibus, fue una corta enseñanza hacia el amar y servir a Dios, dándome la oportunidad para proveer pequeñas reflexiones acerca de la espiritualidad o el ministerio. Señor, elevo Tu Nombre a las Alturas, es un canto de alta energía que nos dice lo que Jesús ha hecho desde la encarnación hasta la ascensión. Es un hermoso recuento del misterio Cristológico.

Igualmente, YO, SU PASTOR, NO ESTOY HACIENDO AUDICIÓN POR AMÉRICA TIENE TALENTO. Ya han pasado muchas lunas desde que yo adopté el sacerdocio, y dejé atrás una carrera prometedoramente teatral en las Filipinas, discerniendo claramente que Dios me llamaba al sacerdocio. No estoy aquí en el sacerdocio para lucir cualquier talento, o para buscar popularidad como un cantante. Esto es absolutamente ridículo. Pero como su sacerdote, solo puedo traerles lo que soy, en mi ministerio sacerdotal, incluyendo mis talentos y experiencias. Así es que, para los que no lo saben, yo en realidad tengo un fuerte don musical, y yo crecí cantando con mi familia en la misa, en la escuela, y después en el teatro y en la televisión. Esto es parte de lo que soy, y Dios me llamó como tal que soy, así es que nunca podré pedir disculpa al usar mis talentos personales en mi ministerio como sacerdote que soy. Yo presento los cantos, e invito a la comunidad a cantar, porque esto es lo que yo sé, este es mi don, y por supuesto lo debo usar. Es muy simple de donde vengo. Cantando es parte de mi espiritualidad y quiero compartirlo con nuestra parroquia. Debemos realizar que el cantar es orar, y cuando cantamos en la iglesia, tenemos a Dios por nuestra única audiencia. También quiero asegurarme y que quede claro que cuando ofrezco un canto en la misa, como oración o reflexión, no estoy buscando que la gente me aplaude a mí, o al canto, o la canción, como si fuera un programa. Yo actualmente prefiero que mantengamos un ambiente lleno de devoción para reflexionar sobre lo que hemos cantado.

Estas no son PIRUETAS públicas. Es una cultura que queremos desarrollar en nuestra parroquia. Queremos desarrollarnos como iglesia que canta, porque ya cantamos muchas de nuestras oraciones, como en la entrada, al final y entre las dos. Repito que es bueno que nuestros fieles se sientan libres al expresarse en oración, levantando las manos o según los mueva el Espíritu, no deben sentirse cohibidos. En nuestra tradición Católica, no hay nada que impide nuestros gestos y movimientos durante la misa, pues estos reflejan nuestros profundos sentimientos. Igualmente, no quiero que sean juzgados, las personas que no están dispuestas a mover sus manos. Únicamente pido que todos estemos abiertos a la inspiración del Espíritu Santo cuando celebramos la misa y cantamos en una manera ordenada y razonable.

Finalmente, les pido, queridos feligreses, educarse uno al otro acerca de esta cultura y espiritualidad. Hay que ayudarnos mutuamente a fomentar la cultura del canto en nuestra parroquia. ¡Que desborde tu corazón en canto aquí en JP2!
