THOUGHTS ON OUR HUMAN CONDITION: Where sin abounds, Grace abounds even more!

Since I was ordained a priest in 2004, the reality of our human condition has struck me straight in the face. I have since been exposed to it daily, I deal with it every day through the people that God has brought to my ministry, in the various circumstances in the life of the parish. Our humanity is such that we are not perfect; we are all broken in this broken world, lost in the deep yogurt of sin and death. From the confessional, to the counseling room, to the quiet corners of the church, as well as the meetings and the gathering spaces, we are surrounded with the possibility of affecting other people with our own incapacities or blindness, ignorance or pride. Sin is everywhere. Temptation is everywhere. Frailty is the permanent reality of our humanity.

THE HARD TRUTH. We are already quite divided because of the closing of our parishes, and the resulting conflict of opinions on how things should look like in our new parish. The changes that have taken place already left many of us feeling unstable or confused. Negativity has pervaded the minds of a certain population of the parish. Some have left bitter and others feel let down or frustrated.

A COMPOUNDING SORROW. Recently we have all been disturbed by the case surrounding Fr. Richard Jacklin, who has served as a priest in the Kankakee County for many years. We are disillusioned by such news, so closely associated with our own community. It is sad both for Fr. Jacklin, but even more so for the victim. All of this issue boils back down to our human condition, our human weakness, our brokenness, and no one is exempted from it. In some way, priests are even more challenged to face such spiritual battles caused by evil within us. Priest or not, young or old, rich or poor, native or foreign, we are all subjected to similar patterns of temptation, and so we can empathize in some way how it came down, even for someone like Fr Jacklin. I have received calls and emails asking how to respond to this issue, and all I came up with was to invoke the rule of law: whoever did something wrong should be held accountable, it doesn't matter if you are a priest or not.

AND STILL ANOTHER BLOW. The ugly face of sin and human frailty has challenged my peace of mind recently, how it is possible for anyone who is given the gift of trust to dishonor it with dishonesty and theft. How easy it is for human beings to discredit the value of one's soul with the most insignificant things, like money and possession. Our parish is in the process of putting up protocols and procedure for the safety of our ways and means, and we have learned the hard way. I promise that we will do our best so that such a situation will not happen again.

A CALL TO COMPASSION. But we are not here to condemn a person; we only condemn that evil deed, the bad choices made. We are called to be compassionate to everyone, even to the worst of sinners. Hopefully, we can be a catalyst to healing and forgiveness, in whatever circumstance we face. In the face of misery caused by sin, I want to believe that we can be bearers of God's mercy.

GOD'S GRACE. Where sin abounds, God's grace abounds even more, says St. Paul in Romans 5:20. I believe this very firmly. God is never outdone, and He can turn the ugliness of human frailty into something positive. This is why I ask that we as a community should unite together in prayer. In all of the disturbing things going on, I know that grace abounds, because I have not lost my focus, and my heart still feels the peace and joy of the Lord. This is only possible because of the outpouring of grace and the spiritual support of prayers. Dear Church, we will see grace abound even more!! We can even see it now...

CONSIDERANDO NUESTRA CONDICIÓN HUMANA: DONDE EL PECADO ABUNDA, LA GRACIA ABUNDA MÁS!

Desde mi ordenación sacerdotal en 2004, la realidad de la condición humana fue algo asombroso. Desde aquel entonces, yo me enfrento a eso diariamente, por medio de la gente que Dios me ha confiado en mi ministerio, y en varias circunstancias de la vida parroquial. Nuestra humanidad es tal, que no somos perfectos; todos somos roturados en este mundo, perdidos en la profundidad del pecado y la muerte. Del confesional, al cuarto de consulta, a los rincones silenciosos de la iglesia, igualmente que a los lugares de reuniones, estamos rodeados con la posibilidad de afectar a otra gente con nuestras propias incapacidades o ceguera, orgullo o ignorancia. El pecado esta por todas partes. La tentación igualmente. La debilidad es la realidad permanente en nuestra humanidad.

LOS HECHOS INDISCUTIBLES. Ya estamos divididos por la clausura de nuestras parroquias, y los consecuentes conflictos de opiniones sobre cómo deben ser las cosas en nuestra nueva parroquia. Los cambios que se han realizado nos han dejado a muchos con un sentir inestable o confusos. La negatividad ha penetrado las mentes de cierta población de la parroquia. Algunos se sienten amargados y otros se sienten frustrados.

UNA TRISTEZA MEZCLADA. Recién nos hemos sentido perturbados por el caso tocante el Padre Richard Jacklin, que ha servido como sacerdote en el Condado de Kankakee por muchos años. Nos sentimos desilusionados por estos acontecimientos asociados con nuestra propia comunidad. Es muy triste tanto para el Padre Jacklin pero más todavía para la víctima. Al fin de las cosas, todo esto procede de nuestra condición humana, nuestra fragilidad, que nadie es exenta. En algunas maneras, los sacerdotes tienen más desafíos en sus batallas espirituales causadas por el maligno dentro de sí. Sea quién sea, todos estamos sujetos a la tentación, y por eso podemos sufrir con el Padre Jacklin. He recibido muchas llamadas y emails preguntando el cómo puedo yo responder a esta situación, y lo único que puedo hacer es invocar la ley: quién hace algo malo debe aclarar y admitir su responsabilidad, ya sea sacerdote o no.

Y TODAVÍA OTRO GOLPE. La cara horrible del pecado y la debilidad humana han desafiado mi paz mental recientemente, cómo puede ser posible para alguien que ha recibido el don de confianza y ha deshonrado con deshonestidad y robo. Que fácil es para un ser humano descreditar el valor de su alma con algo insignificante, como la posesión de dinero. Nuestra parroquia esta en el proceso en identificar procedimientos para resguardar nuestros dineros, y hemos aprendido por dura experiencia. Les prometo que haremos lo mejor posible para que tal situación no vuelva a suceder.

UN LLAMADO A LA COMPASIÓN. Pero no estamos aquí para condenar a una persona, solo condenamos la mala acción, la mala voluntad. Somos llamados a ser compasivos con todos, hasta con el peor pecador. Espero que seamos los primeros en perdonar y sanar, en cualquier situación que se presente. Enfrentándonos a la miseria causada por el pecado, deseo que seamos portadores de la misericordia de Dios.

LA GRACIA DE DIOS. Donde abunda el pecado, la gracia de Dios abunda mucho más, dice San Pablo a los Romanos 5:20. Así lo creo firmemente. Dios nunca se excede a sí mismo, y Él puede transformar los horrores de la debilidad humana en algo positivo. Entonces les pido que como comunidad nos unamos en oración. En todas estas perturbaciones, yo sé que la gracia de Dios abunda, porque no he perdido mi enfoque, y mi corazón todavía se siente en paz y goza en el Señor. Esto proviene por la gracia y el apoyo de oraciones. Querida Iglesia, veremos la gracia en abundancia!! Y ya lo vemos hoy...






