THE WITNESS OF SIMPLY SHOWING UP

Back in Plainfield, IL at my first parish assignment, there was a couple by the name of Joe and Mary, an elderly couple who came to church every Sunday without fail. The Catholic Church in Plainfield, at Saint Mary Immaculate Parish, is the largest in the diocese with over 7,000 registered families. There are many parishioners who come to church every Sunday, but Mary and Joe were not your regular churchgoers. Mary was disabled, and could only come to church on a wheelchair. Joe was also disabled, and could not walk straight because of polio. By Joe and Mary never failed to go to church. Joe would push Mary's wheelchair slowly as they walked to church. He never asked for help, and never even welcomed much help, because he knew he had to do this for his wife. He had to learn to do it. And whenever they came into church, people watched them with eyes of admiration.

Joe and Mary never participated in anything else, but would sometimes show up in some community building events. For the most part, their biggest ministry to the rest of the parish is their quiet witness of their commitment to being present every Sunday, not only for themselves, but perhaps unintentionally, for all of us there who felt edified by their great display of devotion and fortitude amidst the challenges that they both face as a couple. Many years later, I still remember Joe and Mary, especially when I get tempted to complain or to pity myself. Remembering them, I get to tell myself, I can just show up, be present, and perhaps that's enough witness for others.

Showing up and being present at church on Sundays, is a powerful witness to our children we don't have to say much other than perhaps to occasionally tell our children why it is important to say thanks to God as a community. At certain times, it even becomes more critical to show up at church and be present for the celebration of the Eucharist. When it is inconvenient, and we show up, it is an even greater witness. When it is too cold, too hot, too early, too late, to crazy, and whatever other reason there might be and we show up, it is an even more powerful witness of the value of what we celebrate in the Eucharist. On any given Sunday, and I look at everyone who comes to church and think of the many other reasons that they wouldn't be present, I immediately give thanks to God. Thank you, Lord, that they are here, I would whisper with a smile on my face. As a priest, I am most concerned about that. I am most edified to see everyone coming together to celebrate God's love and generosity, as a community, like God would want it.

To be present before God is a special thing. I mean, the truth is, we are always in the presence of God, no matter what. But what is beautiful about being aware of it, by intentionally going to church to be present with the rest of the family, and by celebrating God's unique presence to the Church through Word and Sacrament, is that miracles take place in such moments. I see people finding hope, I hear people tell me about becoming stronger in the midst of their trials, I get to know of people expressing their joy of feeling the Spirit of God alive in our church. This happens when we all show up, when we are all present for one another. This is the beauty of being Church, and in these moments, we put a smile on God's face, as He sees the beauty of our gathered faith.

Thank you, dear Saint John Paul II Church, for being present. Thank you for your witness of faith, thank you for bringing meaning and purpose to all that we do as a family of faith. May we not only continue to be present here, but someday, may we all show up, smiling and full of heavenly joy before the presence of God in His Kingdom. Amen.

EL TESTIMONIO SE VERIFICA AL PRESENTARNOS

Cuando estaba en Plainfield, IL, mi primera asignación parroquial, conocí a una pareja en edad avanzada que continuamente venían a la iglesia los domingos, eran José y María. Esta iglesia, la Parroquia Santa María Inmaculada, es la más grande en la diócesis y cuenta con más de 7,000 familias registradas. Hay muchos feligreses que vienen a la iglesia todos los domingos, pero María y José eran diferentes a los demás. María estaba deshabilitada y podía venir a la iglesia solo en silla de ruedas. José también estaba deshabilitado, y no podía andar derecho porque tenía polio, pero ellos nunca faltaban en ir a la iglesia. José empujaba a María en la silla de ruedas al pasito hacia la iglesia. Él nunca pedía ayuda, ni aceptaba ayuda, porque él quería hacer esto por su esposa. Él tuvo que aprender para hacerlo. Y cuando entraban a la iglesia, toda la gente los veían con admiración.

José y María nunca participaban en nada más, pero algunas veces se presentaban en algunos eventos comunitarios. En general, su mayor ministerio para el resto de la parroquia era su testimonio silencioso de su compromiso y su presencia cada domingo, no para sí mismos, pero quizás sin saberlo, para todos nosotros allí presentes que nos sentíamos edificados por su gran devoción y fuerza de voluntad en medio de los desafíos en sus vidas. Después de muchos años, todavía recuerdo a José y a María, especialmente cuando me siento tentado a quejarme o me siento lastimado. Al recordarlos, me digo a mí mismo, yo puedo simplemente estar presente, y quizás eso será bastante testimonio para los demás.

Estando presente en la iglesia los domingos, es un testimonio poderoso para nuestros niños. En pocas palabras podemos decir a nuestros niños que es muy importante dar gracias a Dios en comunidad. Y todavía es más importante estar presentes a la celebración de la Eucaristía. Cuando es inconveniente, y estamos presentes, eso es todavía un testimonio más grande. Cuando hace mucho frío, mucho calor, muy temprano, muy tarde, una locura, y cualquier otra razón que pueda haber, y estamos allí presentes, eso es todavía un poderoso testimonio al gran valor que tenemos al celebrar la Eucaristía. En cualquier domingo, veo a todos los que vienen a la iglesia y pienso en todas las razones que podrían dar para no estar presentes, y yo inmediatamente doy gracias a Dios. Con una sonrisa, doy gracias al Señor en vos baja por todos los que están aquí. Como sacerdote, ésta es mi gran preocupación. Me siento edificado moralmente cuando todos unidos venimos a celebrar la generosidad y el gran amor de Dios, como Dios lo desearía.

El estar presentes ante Dios es algo muy especial. La realidad es, siempre estamos en la presencia de Dios, pase lo que pase. Pero lo maravilloso es, el estar conscientes de eso y voluntariamente ir a la iglesia, y estar presentes con el resto de la familia, y cuando celebramos la suma presencia de Dios en su Iglesia a través de la Palabra y el Sacramento, es cuando milagros toman lugar en esos momentos. Veo a la gente descubriendo la esperanza, oigo a la gente que me dice que se va sintiéndose con más fuerza en medio de sus aflicciones, estoy enterado de gente que expresa su alegría al sentir que el Espíritu de Dios está viviente en nuestra iglesia. Esto sucede cuando todos venimos y estamos presentes uno con el otro. Esto es lo maravilloso de ser Iglesia, y en estos momentos, ponemos una sonrisa en la faz de Dios, cuando ve lo precioso de nuestra fe en comunidad.

Gracias, mi querida Iglesia San Juan Pablo II, por su presencia. Gracias por su testimonio de fe, gracias por traer sentido y propósito a todo lo que hacemos como familia de fe. Hay que continuar el estar presentes aquí, y un día, estaremos presentes, sonriendo y llenos de alegría celestial ante la presencia de Dios en Su Reino. Amen.
