

Thank you. Gracias. Salamat. Danke. Ačiū. Grazie. Xièxìè, Arigatōgozaimashita. Efcharisto. Obregado. Dziękuje. Spasibo.

One of the most fundamental and universal lessons that every person must learn is how to say thank you. I am certain that our parents and elders taught us those two beautiful words as early as when we were barely starting to speak. It is a gesture of politeness, and an acknowledgment of another person's goodness. Thank you also to our parishioners who generously support our missions and programs, without your generous stewardship, we will not be able to accomplish many things. Thank you, for the joy that each of you have given me, personally, as your unworthy pastor.

This past week, I have been celebrating a lot. I have thanked God for another year of life on November 21, another Thanksgiving time with friends and family, and this weekend, we thank Jesus for being our faithful Universal King. Today marks the end of the liturgical calendar, when we look back at what we have been able to accomplish this year, I cannot help but give thanks. It has been a very demanding and challenging year, but looking back, I see how God has poured out his grace and blessings along the way, providing us with everything that we need to get to where we are today as a parish community.

How beautiful indeed that we have a chance to say thank you, once again. And every time we gather to celebrate mass, we say thank you again. Tirelessly. To God be the glory!




