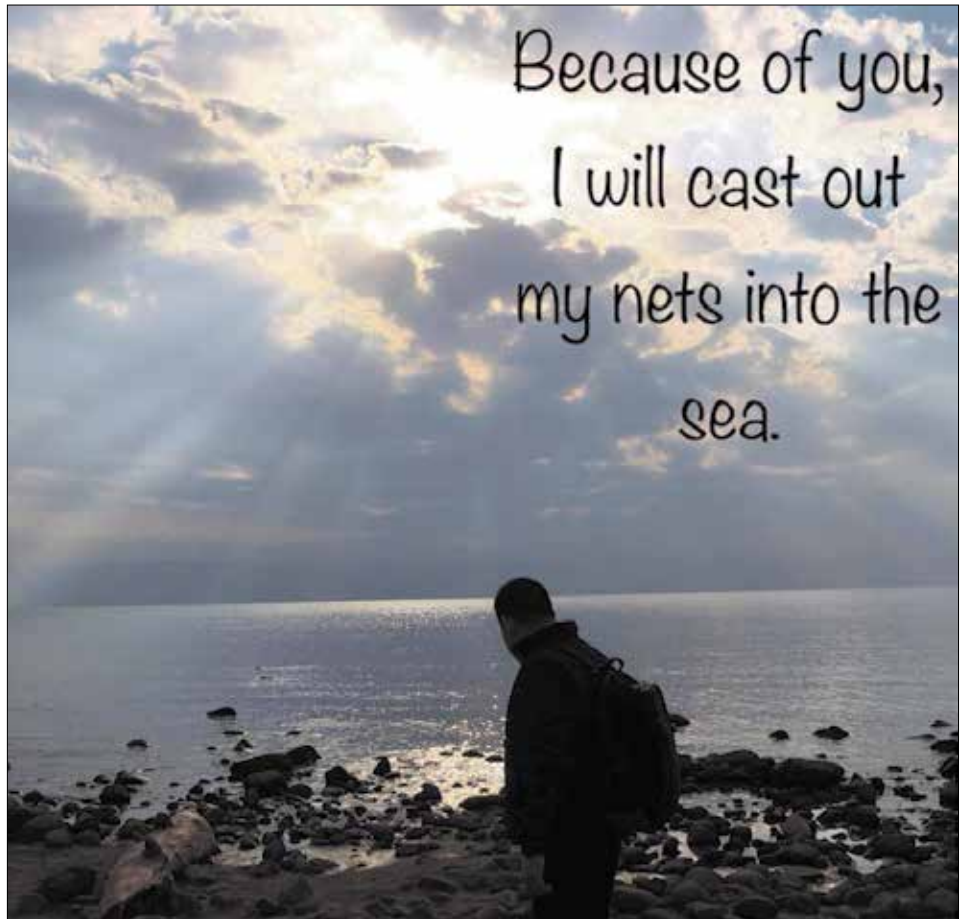

I know that Fr. Sunny likes his church in Kankakee, and he loves the people that he serves. He enjoyed being the pastor of Saint Teresa. We have some good memories there together, when I visited three times since 2011. Many times, when he called my phone, he told me stories about his three parishes, and now he tells me about being the pastor of St. John Paul II. I know this past year was not easy, but God is good and generous and will always be there for you all.

As his mother, I worry about him sometimes. I also worry about his health and his work. But I think many people have been very nice to him, and helped him with the challenges that he has to face. I know that he is in a very good community with many good people. That makes me feel better as a mother. So, I want to say thank you to many parishioners that help him, and those who support his ministry. Being so far away, I am happy that there are many people who are like his parents and family there too. I pray for all of you.

I am looking forward to visit again this year, God willing. Over the years, I have also found many friends in Kankakee who remember me and greet me through Fr. Sunny or through Facebook. I appreciate all of it, including the letters and gifts that you send me through him.

And finally, I thank God for his vocation, and for the time that we have to spend together during these short but happy days. I will always cherish these moments in my heart.
