CELEBRATING OUR HOLY FAMILY SISTERS' 50 GOLDEN YEARS OF MISSIONARY WORK IN AMERICA

The Missionary Sisters of the Holy Family started their mission here in the USA by establishing their community here in Kankakee, with Fr. Mike at the Saint Stanislaus Kostka Church. If we reviewed their story and the work of each nun from fifty years ago to today, we can easily see that they have successfully integrated themselves in the community, and today, they have three communities in the United States. Aside from Kankakee, they also have communities in Wisconsin and Florida. Later on, they would of course move to their convent on Water Street, within the boundaries of the former Saint Martin Church, and now as part of the parish of Saint John Paul II. We celebrate with them, and I personally extend my loving congratulations and blessings to their entire community.

We are blessed this weekend with the presence of their Mother General, Weronika Mackiewicz, as well as the sisters from the three communities, to give thanks to God for this milestone in the history of their congregation. Some of their fellow sisters from other religious communities are here to join with them in giving thanks to God. And some of their priest friends from various religious communities are also present with us. I welcome everyone with the same sentiment that it is good to be here together, to celebrate the many ways that our Holy Family sisters have helped nourish us spiritually and inspired us all to live a life of poverty, chastity and obedience. They have planted seeds of faith to so many, particularly to the young people. They have planted seeds of hope to so many that they serve at the hospital. They have sowed seeds of love with so many people in our community. The seeds are plentifully sown indeed, and the Catholic Church in Kankakee is a better community today because of the fruits that we are now reaping from those seeds that have been sown for fifty years.

If someone asked me to describe the Holy Family sisters, here is what I would say today:

They are a community of happy women. It is easy to see that happiness even just by observing them from afar. They are always smiling, or having a fun conversation. One time, I was having breakfast with them at one of the diners in the area, and the waitress said, "It is so good to see happy people coming for breakfast." They simply exude that happiness, because there is so much happiness in being a religious person.

They are a community of women who sincerely love one another as sisters, and generously love all the others the same way. I have seen how they care for each other in many circumstances. I guess it goes with the territory of being a nun to be nice and kind and loving towards others.

They are a community of holy women. These sisters have shown their love of God by their life of prayer, devotion and acts of holy sacrifice. They have a very consistent prayer life, and even in their busy lives, they try their best to maintain a steady prayer life. They even fast and abstain every Friday!

As they celebrate fifty years of ministry in the USA, it is my prayer that their community continue to grow, that more young women find their charisma and way of life a clear option for holiness of life. I pray that our sisters continue to be happy, healthy and holy always. We love you and we feel blessed that you are a part of our spiritual family. **Niech dobry Pan zawsze oświecła wam drogę. Son una comunidad de mujeres quienes sinceramente se aman las unas con las otras y generosamente aman a todos de la misma manera. He visto como se preocupan las unas por las otras en varias circunstancias. Creo que viene con el territorio de ser monja el ser bueno, bondadoso y amar a los demás.

Son una comunidad de mujeres santas. Estas mujeres han denostado su amor a Dios con su vida de oración y aún en sus vidas tan ocupadas, tratan de hacer lo mejor para mantener una vía de oración constante. Ayunan y se abstienen todos los viernes!

Mientras celebran cincuenta años de ministerio en USA, es mi oración que su comunidad continúe creciendo, que más mujeres jóvenes encuentren su carisma y modo de vida una clara opción por una vida de santidad. Pido que nuestras hermanas continúen siendo felices, saludables y siempre santas. 




