INTO THE DEEP: OUR LENTEN MISSION

Next Sunday begins our parish mission! I am very excited to invite our parish family to this year's Lenten mission experience entitled: "Into the Deep". For these three days of praying, sharing, witnessing and inspiring, I am pleased to introduce our speakers:



SR. CAROL KARNITSKY, SSCM. Sr. Carol is the new provincial superior of the Sisters of the Holy Heart of Mary, the religious community most known to us for their apostolate with St. Mary's Hospital here in Kankakee. Sr. Carol grew up at St. Gall Parish in Chicago. It was in this parish that she first developed a sense of calling to the religious life, through the inspiration of the priests and nuns in her parish. She entered the convent at the age of seventeen, and since then has given her entire life to the charisma of her congregation by serving as an elementary school teacher, campus minister, pastoral associate, and vice-president for a Catholic healthcare system. She has spent many years of serving parish ministry, and as she returns to Kankakee as provincial of her community, she also blesses our parish in many unique ways by leading some morning services, and teaching with our RCIA Team.

FR. MARK BERNHARDT. Fr. Mark was born on a farm in Elwood, IL. He did his undergraduate at Olivet Nazarene University. Upon graduating from Olivet, he became a missionary for FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) at the University of Nebraska. He was ordained a priest for the Joliet Diocese this past May and is currently the associate pastor at Our Lady of Mercy Catholic Church in Aurora. Fr. Mark loves to use his passion for sports to bring people to Jesus. Even as a seminarian, he has organized vocation promotion groups through basketball events in parishes and has been passionate about the work of evangelization. He has a twin sister, loves St. John Paul II, and is convinced the Cubs will have another parade in 2018.

MR. ROBERT GUASTALLI. Bob Guastalli was born and raised at St. Albie's Parish in Chicago, but has been a resident of Kankakee for about thirty years, since he was married to Valerie, daughter of Bob & Zondra Cross. Blessed with seven children, who are now also excellent young Catholics in our community, Bob would understand the ups and downs of relationships and family life, and dealing with challenges and setbacks in his own faith journey. In this mission, he will give us a witness talk on how our relationship with God can affect and help our relationships with people around us, and also help us to the biggest challenges of our lives. Bob keeps himself busy these days with his work as a nurse, by working in home healthcare service.

During our three-day mission, I am excited to invite our parishioners to various spiritual experiences, including faith-sharing about our conversion stories, confessions, written testimonials, and prayers. We will also celebrate mass on the last day of the mission. I am praying that this will be a cathartic experience for our parishioners, and will bring renewal in our spiritual life.

We will be focusing on the most basic things about our faith, including stories of conversion, our thoughts on enriching our love of God and the Church, and taking to heart our calling to be disciples and witnesses of God to the world. Along the way we will invite our parishioners to share their stories of faith and have the opportunity to offer testimony to what God does in their lives. I ask then that we mark our calendars for the Lenten Mission, March 11, 12 and 13 at 6 PM. I am confident that it will be an inspiring and spiritually nourishing experience for all of us.
