## WHAT A DINNER!

As your pastor, I will never ever be tired of asking you to participate in the events and community-building activities in our parish. I am very convinced that this is essential for us to grow together as one Church, as a community of disciples, as a family of faith. As I said in another article long time ago, active participation of parishioners in events and community activities is a sign of a healthy and thriving church community. When we don't participate in our activities, we start to die.

**50'S DINNER AND DANCE.** We just finished a successful dinner dance fundraiser, thanks to the help and leadership of Kathy Dummer and her awesome team. I witnessed in this event a collaborative spirit among parishioners, and the participation was such that most people who went to the dinner actually did wear 50's style clothes. Some gentlemen even wore wigs in order to take us back to that decade. One parishioner even took the time to sew in a JP2 sign on his sweater! Some of the ladies came in as a team, wearing the same 50's outfit, sporting their jeans and pink lady bandanas. I hope everyone gets to check some of the pictures on Facebook, to have an idea what a special event it was. I myself do not know much about the 50's, but I got out of there feeling like I learned much more about the culture of that era.

**DINNER WITH TWELVE NEW FRIENDS.** When I sounded super enthusiastic during the announcement, when I was inviting you to the Dinner with Twelve New Friends that was because I really was excited! Even before we became JP2 Parish, this activity had already been forging people's lives and bridging gaps among our parish families. It has been common through the years that someone would say, "Yes, we're friends and we met at the dinner..." I myself have gotten to know parishioners better because of this dinner event. It is probably true for most dinner events, but particularly in this one, where the intention is to really get to know one another. When we come to think of it, this model of eating and knowing each other goes back to the time of Jesus. Remember how Jesus ask Zacchaeus to come down from the sycamore tree because he will have dinner at his house? Or how about the last supper? How appropriate that Jesus instituted the sacrament of His Body and Blood over dinner! This tells us that as a church family, eating together is something that we should do.

**LAST WEDNESDAY BREAKFASTS.** Many parishioners do not know that we have a last Wednesday breakfast after the morning mass of that day. Not only do we get nourished by word and sacrament at daily mass, we also get to do some fellowship and community building among our spiritual powerhouse of daily mass goers. I am happy that since we have become a new parish, the number of those who come to morning mass has increased. And for those who are able, I invite you to come to morning mass and develop this special habit of beginning your day with Jesus. There are so many spiritual and practical benefits to it, for the individual person but also for the entire church.

During the Season of Lent, I reflect about the ways that God is helping us to become a more united parish. He has blessed us indeed with the difficult task of tearing down parish boundaries in order to get to where we are today – sharing the same banquet from the same table of the Lord! And as we come closer to the first Holy Week of our parish, I cannot but feel delighted at the amazing things in store for us as a spiritual family. It gives me joy to know that God's work is joyfully happening in our midst, beginning from our Eucharistic meals, to our meals of building community, all for a better service to God and our community. God bless our parish!
