

HAPPY JP2 EASTER 2018

Happy Easter, my dear John Paul II Parish! This is our first Easter Season together as JP2 parish, and after our beautiful Lenten season and Triduum, I am elated and joyful to be in this season with you.

Today is April 1, and many people chuckle at the idea that we celebrate Jesus' resurrection today. If during Jesus' time, they knew what April Fool's Day meant, they would have all laughed when someone told them today that Jesus has risen from the dead. They would have received the news as an April Fool's joke, or a big ridiculous fake news. Thank heavens, we know today that Jesus' triumph over the grave is no joking matter, because it is the foundation of our Christianity. Jesus' resurrection completes the divine teaching about eternal life with God. His resurrection tells us that all of us who have been redeemed by the death of Jesus on the cross will also raise to new life with Him. The ancient curse of sin has been broken, even more amazingly than when the Cubs broke the curse of the goat in 2016. There is then every reason to celebrate with joyful refrains of Alleluia because we celebrate as a church the triumph of new life.

What makes this Easter 2018 especially joyful? Let me count the reasons.

1. Barely on our tenth month as a new parish, I feel that we have accomplished so many things together. Our outreach, evangelization and community-building efforts have been very well executed, and our roster of volunteers and supporters continue to grow.
2. We have faced many challenges to get to where we are these days, but it is important for us to focus on loving God and fostering the undeniable presence of the Holy Spirit in the church. This is at the heart of all that we do.
3. I see more young people coming to church. I have noticed some new faces recently who have been attending our liturgies. Perhaps, this is an initial response to our efforts to reach this population of our community.
4. There is a growing desire for many of our parishioners to rediscover their faith, through spirituality events. I am hoping that in the next fiscal year, we can introduce from spirituality revival programs. We need this very badly these days, and I know God will lead this pathway for our parish.
5. During Holy Week, we received the announcement from the diocese that we will have a new parochial vicar here at Saint John Paul II for the new fiscal year. He is still a transitional deacon right now and will be ordained in May, with Deacon Jesus Oliveros, and so by the time he comes to Kankakee, he will be Fr. John Horan. I am confident that he will bring a new dynamism for our parish that will be good for what we are continuing to accomplish here.
6. I am also looking forward to the rest of the month of April, as we will be celebrating First Communion masses in our 11:30 Sunday liturgies, and for the first time since my ordination, I will be officiating our parish confirmation this year, upon the appointment of Bishop Conlon.

Dear parishioners, I continue to ask you for prayers. As we attempt to be a better community of faith, we know that we will also continue to be faced with the forces of the enemy in all its forms. As we celebrate the Season of Easter, let us continue to hold on to the triumph of Jesus over all forces of the enemy, and therefore, as a church we continue to invoke the name of Jesus our Victor through these challenging times.

God bless our parish. May the Eastertime bring about the budding forth of renewed vigor, enthusiasm and devotion in our community. Amen. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!

Estoy seguro que traerá una nueva dinámica para nuestra iglesia que será buena para lo que queremos continuar logrando.
6. También estoy emocionado esperando el resto del mes de Abril, mientras celebraremos las Misas de Primeras Comuniones en nuestras liturgias de los Domingos a las 11:30 y por primera vez desde mi ordenación, estaré oficiando las confirmaciones en nuestra parroquia este año, con el nombramiento del Obispo Conlon.

Queridos feligreses, continuo pidiendo sus oraciones. Mientras intentamos ser una mejor comunidad de fe, sabemos que también continuaremos enfrentando con las fuerzas del enemigo en todas sus formas. 


