TO BE A CHURCH OF GOD'S MERCY: JOHN PAUL II AND DIVINE MERCY



During the morning masses on Sunday, I made mention that it makes sense for our parish to celebrate Divine Mercy. John Paul II and the whole devotion to the Divine Mercy are very much intertwined, together with St. Faustina. Pope John Paul II, both in his teaching and personal life, strove to live and teach the message of Divine Mercy. As the great Mercy Pope, he wrote an encyclical on Divine Mercy: *"The Message of Divine Mercy has always been near and dear to me... which I took with me to the See of Peter and which it in a sense forms the image of this Pontificate."*

In his writings and homilies, he has described Divine Mercy as the answer to the world's problems and the message of the third millennium. He beatified and canonized Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska, the nun associated with the message, and he did it in Rome and not in Poland to underscore that Divine Mercy is for the whole world.

Establishing Divine Mercy Sunday for the Entire Church. When Pope John Paul canonized Sr. Faustina (making her St. Faustina), he also, on the same day, surprised the entire world by establishing Divine Mercy Sunday (the feast day associated with the message) as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season. On that day, Pope John Paul II declared, "This is the happiest day of my life."

Entrusting the World to the Divine Mercy. In 2002, the Pope entrusted the whole world to Divine Mercy when he consecrated the International Shrine of The Divine Mercy in Lagiewniki, a suburb of Krakow in Poland. This is where St. Faustina's mortal remains are entombed. The saint lived in a convent nearby. The Pope himself remembers as a young man working in the Solvay Quarry, just a few meters from the present-day Shrine. He also says that he had been thinking about Sr. Faustina for a long time when he wrote his encyclical on Divine Mercy. Further, the Holy Father has frequently quoted from the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska and has prayed The Divine Mercy Chaplet at the saint's tomb.

Beyond the Life of John Paul II. Given all these connections to Divine Mercy and St. Faustina, is it any wonder that Pope John Paul II died on the Vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday (the evening before the feast day), which fell that year (2005) on April 3? It is also no surprise that the Great Mercy Pope left us a message for Divine Mercy Sunday, which was read on the feast day by a Vatican official to the faithful in St. Peter's after a Mass that had been celebrated for the repose of the soul of the Pope. Repeatedly Pope John Paul II has written and spoken about the need for us to turn to the mercy of God as the answer to the specific problems of our times. He has placed a strong and significant focus on the Divine Mercy message and devotion throughout his pontificate that will carry the Church long after his death.

Being a Parish of Mercy. Because our parish is named under the patronage of St. John Paul the Great, it is incumbent upon us not only to celebrate this special feast, but more importantly, to hone it as an integral part of our parish culture. We need mercy in order to manifest to our community that God is in our church. It is by God's mercy that we are spared from the suffering that we deserve, and it is also by God's mercy that we are healed from our wounds caused by sins. Allow me then, my dear parishioners, to send the message of mercy to everyone: "To be merciful is to show forgiveness, and forgiveness is not only God's command, but also at the heart of God's Divine life. Let us live in mercy, so that as a church, we may become the dwelling place of God."

PARA SER UNA IGLESIA DE LA MISERICORDIA DE DIOS: SAN JUAN PABLO II Y LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Durante las misas de la mañana del Domingo, mencioné que tiene sentido para nuestra parroquia celebrar la Divina Misericordia. Juan Pablo II y toda la devoción a la Divina Misericordia están muy entrelazados con Sta. Faustina. El Papa Juan Pablo II, en ambos enseñanza y su vida personal, luchó para vivir y enseñar el Mensaje de la Divina Misericordia. Como el gran Papa Misericordioso, escribió una encíclica de la Divina Misericordia: " El Mensaje de la Divina Misericordia siempre ha estado cerca y ha sido muy querido por mí... lo cual lleve conmigo al See of Peter (Estado del Vaticano) y el cual en cierto sentido forma la imagen de este Pontificado."

En sus escrituras y homilias, ha descrito la Divina Misericordia como la respuesta a los problemas del mundo y el mensaje del tercer milenio. El beatífico y canonizó a la Hermana María Faustina Kowalska, la monja asociada con el mensaje y lo hizo en Roma y no en Polonia para dar énfasis de que la Divina Misericordia es para todo el mundo.

Estableciendo el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia para toda la Iglesia.

Cuando el Papa Juan Pablo II canonizó a la Hermana Faustina (convirtiéndola en Sta. Faustina), también el mismo día, sorprendió al mundo entero estableciendo el Domingo de Divina Misericordia (la festividad asociada con el mensaje) como el día de fiesta para la Iglesia entera. El día de la festividad cae el Segundo Domingo de la temporada del Domingo de Pascua. En ese día, el Papa Juan Pablo II declaró, "Este es el día mas feliz de mi vida."

Encomendando al Mundo a la Divina Misericordia.

En el 2002, el Papa encomendó a todo el mundo a La Divina Misericordia cuando consagró el Sagrario Internacional de La Divina Misericordia en Lagiewniki, un suburbio de Krakow en Polonia. Aquí es donde los restos mortales de Santa Faustina están enterrados. La Santa vivía en un convento cercano. El Papa recuerda que cuando joven trabajaba en Solvay Quarry (una Presa) solo algunos metros del Santuario hoy en día. También dice, había estado pensando en la Hermana Faustina por mucho tiempo cuando escribió su encíclica a la Divina Misericordia. Además el Santo Padre frecuentemente ha mencionado del diario de Sta. Maria Faustina Kowalska y ha rezado La Coronilla de La Divina Misericordia en la tumba de la Santa.

Más allá de la Vida de San Juan Pablo II.

Dadas todas estas conexiones con la Divina Misericordia y Sta. Faustina es de asombro que el Papa Juan Pablo II murió en la Vigilia del Domingo de La Divina Misericordia (por la tarde antes del día de la festividad), la cual cayó en ese año (2005) en Abril 3? Tampoco no es sorpresa que el Grandioso Misericordioso Papa nos dejó un mensaje para el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, el cual fue leído en día de la festividad por un oficial Vaticano a los fieles en San Pedro después de la Misa que se celebró por el descanso del alma del Papa. Repetidamente el Papa Juan Pablo II escribió y hablo de la necesidad de que recurramos a la Misericordia de Dios como la respuesta de los problemas específicos de nuestro tiempo. El ha puesto un enfoque fuerte y significativo en el mensaje y devoción de La Divina Misericordia durante su pontificado que llevara la Iglesia mucho después de su muerte.

Ser una Parroquia Misericordiosa.

Porque nuestra parroquia esta nombrada bajo el patronee de San Juan Pablo el Grandioso, es obligación nuestra no solo de celebrar esta festividad, pero aún mas importante perfeccionarlo como parte integral de nuestra cultura parroquial. Necesitamos misericordia para poder manifestar a nuestra comunidad que Dios está en nuestra parroquia. Es por la misericordia de Dios que estamos dispensados del sufrimiento que merecemos y es también por la Misericordia de Dios que somos sanados de nuestras heridas causadas por el pecado. Permítanme mis queridos feligreses, mandar el mensaje de misericordia a todos: "Ser misericordioso es mostrar perdón y el perdón no es solo el mandato de Dios pero también en el corazón de la vida de Dios. Vivamos en misericordia, para que como iglesia, podamos convertirnos en la morada de Dios."
