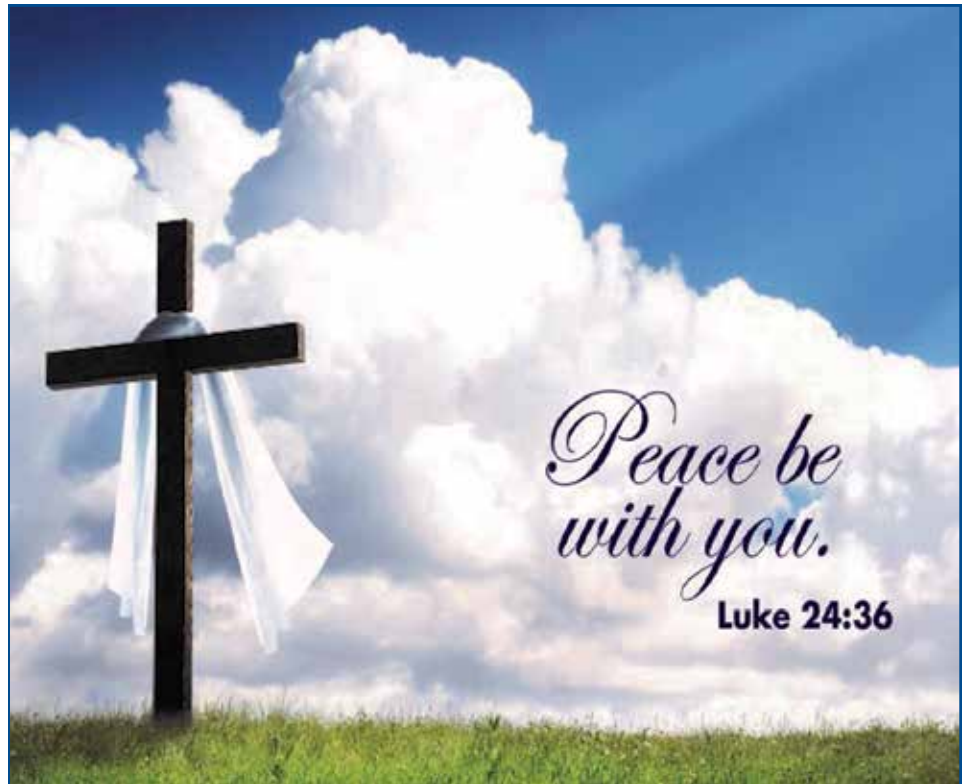

THE EVIL OF GOSSIP AND THE POWER OF GOOD CONSCIENCE



In a community where everybody knows everybody, and the degree of separation is usually two, one of the biggest temptations that happen is gossip. It usually starts with someone starting a false idea out of hate or ill will. That idea is then dropped in a casual conversation, or a small group, and then it gets circulated from one ear to the next, and before you know it, the gossip starts churning, destroying a person or a group of people. Gossip has many forms:

SLANDER (Purposeful attempt to destroy a person through false information.)

DISHING (Spreading a "juicy information" with or without any intention to cause harm.)

RUMORS (Upon hearing something that is not confirmed, you then investigate further by asking questions, and by doing so, the unconfirmed idea gets passed on destructively.)

BACKBITING (Pretending to be nice in front of a person and then secretly talking malice about him/her behind his back.)

NOT-REALLY-JOKING JOKES (Saying something deemed to be funny but is actually destructive of someone's character, and usually takes the form of mockery or sarcasm.)

INNUENDO (Making comments that can make another person assume that something is wrong with another person's character. It is like an indirect gossip, but gossip nonetheless.)

GOT-IT-ALL-WRONG (You admit openly that it is probably not true but you tell it anyway.)

HE SAID / SHE SAID (Repeating something that someone said, without really knowing for sure about it, and passing it to others maliciously.)

Gossip is evil, and this is one of Satan's easiest strategies in destroying God's work. What's more, gossip does not actually destroy the good person, but it destroys the one who gossips. That is how ill will works. No matter what we say, if a person is innocent, that person may suffer from the bad reputation, but his innocence will keep him peaceful, and will be vindicated, in the final judgment by his good conscience. But the one who spreads the malicious gossip is the one who will suffer the punishment and will lose the final peace. Gossip destroys the gossiper, and has no final power over the one subjected to the gossip.

As family of God here in St. John Paul II, I ask you to help dispel the power of darkness by being careful not to be caught in this horrible spiritual disease. This culture of gossip can be very harmful, and maim the spirit of our church. In this Season of Easter, let us spread the Good News that truly matters. Let us talk about God's love and mercy. Let us proclaim Jesus, and teach others about the beauty of our faith. Let us shout to the mountaintops that our God is good, and declare by the witness of our lives that God triumphs over evil, and righteousness prevails over all sin and malice. Pray for the conversion of sinners, and for God's grace to be poured out upon us. God bless our church!

En una comunidad donde todos se conocen, una de las más grandes tentaciones que sucede es el chisme. Usualmente empieza con alguien que comienza una falsa idea por odio o una mala idea. Entonces esa idea sale en una conversación casual, o en un grupo pequeño y luego empieza a circular de oído a oído y antes de que lo sepas el chisme se empieza a revolver, destruyendo a una persona o grupo de personas. El Chisme tiene muchas formas:

CALUMNIA (Propósito de atentar destruir a una persona a través de falsa información.)

REPARTIENDO (Divulgar "información jugosa" con o sin ninguna intención de causar daño.)

RUMORES (Al enterarse de algo que no está confirmado, entonces tú investigas más allá haciendo preguntas y al hacerlo la idea sin confirmar se pasa destructivamente.)

DIFAMAR (Pretender ser amable delante de una persona y luego secretamente hablar de ellos con malicia a sus espaldas.)

REALMENTE- NO ES - GRACIOSO (Decir algo considerado gracioso pero en realidad es destructivo para alguien, es como un chisme indirecto pero sin embargo no deja de ser chisme.)

TODO MAL ENTENDIDO (Admites abiertamente que probablemente no es verdad pero lo dices de todas maneras.)

EL DIJO/ELLA DIJO (Repitiendo algo que alguien dijo, sin saber en verdad con seguridad y pasarlo a otros con malicia.)

El Chisme es malo, esta es una de las estrategias más fáciles de Satanás para destruir el trabajo de Dios. Mas, el chisme realmente no destruye a la buena persona, pero destruye al chismoso. Hace es como funcionará. No importa lo que digamos, si una persona es inocente, puede sufrir de mala reputación, pero su inocencia lo mantiene en paz y será justificado el día del juicio por su buena conciencia. Pero el que riega los malos chismes es el que sufrirá el castigo y sufrirá la paz final. El chisme destruye al chismoso y no tiene poder final sobre el que esta sujeto al chisme.

Recemos por la conversión de los pecadores y por la gracia de Dios derramada sobre nosotros. Dios bendiga nuestra iglesia!

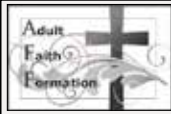

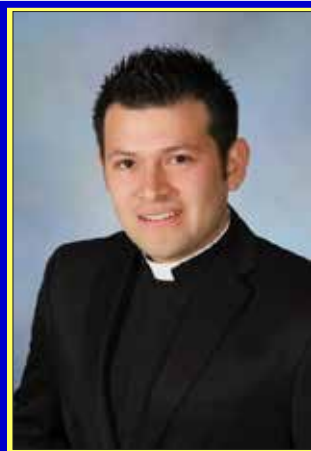
