

GOD'S HAPPINESS PLAN

We are all born with our vocations, I mean, God's Plan for our lives. The consecrated life is a mystery vocation. There is no fixed age for God to review one's call. Many young people called to consecrated life try to wrestle with God or give Him a deaf ear as I tried to do in my life, but He was stronger than I.

When I was 6, I met with 2 Italian missionary nuns and I admired them. I told my mom when I grow up I will be like them, but she didn't take it seriously of course, I was too young. As I was growing up with the same desire, my mom and my siblings were really against my idea. Then, when I was 16, I started to experience a lot of doubts, why me? I am not worthy of this kind of life, no one in my family had this kind of vocation. I tried my best to push away the desire from me. I stopped going to Mass or praying in order not to think of becoming a nun.

During my final year in high school the desire became stronger though I tried to ignore it. This time I had to share my feelings and struggles with my dad. I was surprised that he was so supportive. I started college and after that I started my first job. During my time in college and work I started attending daily mass and reflecting over my life seriously; what did God really want from me? At age 23, my parents blessed me and I left home to the convent to try and see if religious life was my vocation. The congregation journeyed with me in discerning my vocation. I was given the opportunity to study and to work in different countries. When I was 33, by God's grace, I made a decision to embrace consecrated life and made perpetual vows.

Struggle coming to U.S.A: In consecrated/religious life, we have to be open to join any of our communities of Missionary Sisters of the Holy Family if needed. So, decisions were made, and I was asked to join my sisters here in Kankakee in the US. I struggled to accept the request from my congregation due to the following reasons: 1). It was difficult to leave my aging parents; mom is 72 and dad 76, 2). To break the news to mom and dad about my leaving. 3). To face the reality of entering the unknown: Will the people (St. JP2 parish) accept me? I was confused with all these and a few more challenges. God spoke to me through my youngest brother about my fear and worries of coming to Kankakee, simply he challenged me, "What in the world can prevent you from doing GOD's work? What is more important?" I couldn't imagine the wisdom and words of faith he used. When I arrived, to my surprise, the Pastor Fr. Sunny and many of parishioners welcomed me so warmly, so friendly!!! These made me feel a part of the JP2 Family at once. To be sincere, I love you all! All of you whom I met are great people and I count each one of you as God's gift to me.

Not only you welcomed me so lovingly, you also entrusted me your children as FFP coordinator. Today with God's help together with the FFP team here at JP11, we are striving to build a great program to help our children to grow more in faith and love of God.

Today I am happy and have joy in my heart. I thank God for the gift of my vocation, the Missionary Sisters of the Holy Family, and the gift of St. JP2 Family. Why am I sharing all these? Today in the whole world there are many people who are unhappy because they turned away from God's call. So I would like to encourage our young people to listen and to discern before entering any vocation. God has a plan for you, plan for Happiness!!!

EL PLAN DE FELICIDAD DE DIOS

Todos nacemos con nuestras vocaciones, quiero decir, El plan de Dios para nuestras vidas. La vida consagrada es una vida misteriosa. No hay una edad fija para que Dios revise su llamado. Varios jóvenes llamados a la vida consagrada tratan de luchar con Dios o darle el oído sordo como yo trate de hacerlo en mi vida, pero El fue mas fuerte que yo.

Cuando tenia 6 años conocí a dos monjas Italianas misioneras y las admiraba. Le dije a mi mamá cuando crezca quiero ser igual que ellas, pero claro que ella no lo tomó en serio, yo estaba muy chica. Mientras crecía con el mismo deseo, mi mamá y mis hermanos estaban en contra de mi idea. Luego cuando tenia 16 comencé a experimentar muchas dudas, porque yo? Yo no soy digna de esta clase de vida, nadie en mi familia tenia esta clase de vocación. Trate lo mejor que pude de hacer este deseo a un lado. Deje de ir a misa, o de rezar para no pensar en querer ser monja.

Durante mi año final de secundaria el deseo se hizo más fuerte aunque trate de ignorarlo. Esta vez tuve que compartir mis sentimientos y luchas con mi papá. Me sorprendió que fue tan apoyador. Empecé la universidad y después de eso mi primer trabajo. Durante mi tiempo en la universidad y el trabajo empecé a ir a misa diario y a reflexionar seriamente sobre mi vida; que quería en realidad Dios de mí? A los 23 años mis padres me dieron la bendición y me fui de casa al convento para tratar de ver si la vida religiosa era mi vocación. Se me dio la oportunidad de estudiar y trabajar en diferentes países. Cuando tenia 33 años por la gracia de Dios, tome la decisión de adoptar la vida consagrada y hacer votos perpetuos.

Luchando con la venida a los Estados Unidos: En la vida consagrada/vida religiosa, tenemos que estar abiertas a unirnos a nuestras comunidades de las Hermanas Misioneras de la Sagrada Familia si es necesario. Entonces, se tomaron las decisiones y se me pidió que me uniera a mis hermanas aquí en Kankakee en los Estados Unidos. Luche en aceptar la solicitud de mi congregación por las siguientes razones: 1). Fue difícil para mi dejar a mis padres ya de edad; mama tiene 72 y papa tiene 76, 2). Dar la noticia a mamá y papá que me iba. 3). Enfrentar la realidad a lo desconocido: Me aceptará la gente (San Juan Pablo II)? Estaba confundida con esto y algunos otros desafíos. Dios me hablo por medio de mi hermano mas joven acerca de mis miedos y preocupaciones con la venida a Kankakee, simplemente me desafío, "Que en el mundo te puede impedir hacer el trabajo de Dios? Que es mas importante? No pude imaginarme la sabiduría y las palabras de fe que utilizó. Cuando llegue, para mi sorpresa, el Pastor Padre Sunny y varios feligreses me dieron una bienvenida muy cálida y amistosa!!! Esto me hizo sentir parte de la Familia de JP2. Para ser sincera los amo a todos! A todos los que conozco son buenas personas y a cada uno los cuento como un regalo de Dios para mi.

No solamente me recibieron con tanto amor, también me confiaron a sus niños como la coordinadora del programa de FFP. Hoy con la ayuda de Dios juntos con el equipo de FFP aquí en JP11, estamos esforzándonos para construir un gran programa para ayudar a nuestros niños a crecer mas en la fe y el amor de Dios.

Hoy estoy feliz y tengo alegría en mi corazón. Les doy las gracias por el regalo de mi vocación, las Hermanas Misioneras de la Sagrada Familia y el regalo de La Familia de San JP2. Porque estoy compartiendo todo esto? Hoy en todo el mundo hay personas que son infelices porque se alejaron del llamado de Dios. Entonces me gustaría animar a los jóvenes a escuchar y de cernir antes de ingresar a cualquier vocación. Dios tiene un plan para tí, plan para la felicidad!!!


