## THE MARY MONTH OF MAY

May is known in the Catholic Church as the month of Mary. It is the month when we do May Crowning, which will take place here in our parish next weekend.

How beautiful it is that we start of the weekend masses this month with a special celebration for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparition of our Lady at Fatima. I want to take this opportunity to welcome our visitors and friends from the World Apostolate of Fatima, who are leading us in this weekend's celebration, at our 11:30 mass, followed by a solemn festival procession and santacruzan, a special type of spring procession that happens in the Philippines during this month of flowers. This kind of celebration and procession is the first of its kind here in Kankakee, and I am proud that we are hosting it here at Saint John Paul II. It is my hope and prayer that our experience of this devotion will inspire us in many ways.

As St. John Paul II has a very special love for the Virgin Mary, so our parish has to develop the same. Our patron saint taught various ways to deepen our devotion to Mary, including the praying of the rosary, which he enriched by the addition of his luminous mysteries. Our parish does pray the rosary every Thursday evening, but it is also highly encouraged that this form of meditation be done in our homes, so that the whole family can pray together, and develop a culture of common prayers. It is also encouraged that the rosary is prayed individually, and regularly, in order to grow in one's spiritual life. The rosary is a tool of meditation using the Hail Mary as a mantra for internalization. The one who prays the rosary then is able to focus more deeply in meditating on the life, ministry, passion and resurrection of Jesus, and how the truths of our faith can be applied in our own lives. I can imagine how Saint John Paul II can be proud of us if we as a parish grow in such devotion.

During this Mary month of May, we are also making some effort to bring forward some themes on vocation, to invite our parishioners to think about what God is asking of their lives, beginning from the universal vocation to holiness, to the individual calling to serve God in our own unique ways. We are also focusing on listening to some personal witnesses on vocations, which we started last weekend with Sr. Magdalena at our 9:30 AM Mass. I am excited that during this month, we will celebrate the first thanksgiving mass of Deacon Jesús Oliveros who will then be a newly ordained priest. I am hoping that these efforts will bring us finally to imitate the inspiration of Mary, who responded so lovingly and generously to the vocation that God has given her – to be the Mother of Jesus. Her “fiat” is one that has really served to bring the story of salvation to its apex – the resurrection of Jesus!

Here at Saint John Paul II Parish, we continue to focus on the tradition of the Catholic Church, and celebrate Her richness. The Mary month of May is a wonderful time for all of these, and I am elated to be part of it. God bless our parish!

Quiero tomar esta oportunidad para dar la bienvenida a nuestros visitantes y amigos del Apostolado Mundial de Fátima, quienes nos están dirigiendo en la celebración este fin de semana en nuestra misa de las 11:30 seguida del festival de la procesión solemne y santacruzan, una clase de procesión especial de primavera que sucede en las Filipinas durante este mes de flores. Esta clase de celebración y procesión es la primera de su tipo aquí en Kankakee y estoy orgulloso de que somos los anfitriones aquí en San Juan Pablo II. Es mi esperanza y súplica que nuestra experiencia de esta devoción nos inspire de varias maneras.




