ONE AMAZING YEAR!

This Sunday, July 1, 2018, we celebrate our first year as Saint John Paul II Parish! It seems only like yesterday when we started celebrating masses as a new parish. And now, we have already finished a full year and we are caught with feelings of surprise, gratitude, pride and appreciation for the many things that we accomplished. So, please allow me to look back at some of the highlights of our first year as a parish:

LAUNCHING OF THE PARISH. I remember lighting and releasing lanterns last year at the open field. It was late night, and the idea was to meet the launching day of our parish. There were many people just casually sitting and eating, and sharing stories. We had a fun time, and prayed together for our new parish.

PARISH MINISTRY FAIR. This was a very special day, when we showed to our community what our new parish is doing, how we were able to integrate all our ministries from the three parishes to the one new parish that we are now. It made me feel so proud of what we do, and our ministry fair was so successfully done that it gave a good encouraging push for our parishioners to participate in our community.

PASTOR INSTALLATION. That was my fourth installation as a pastor by Bishop Conlon in a span of only seven years. I most likely have the record for being the most installed pastor by Bishop Conlon in the Diocese of Joliet! The pastor installation made it real for me that a new beginning had really taken place again.

BLESSING AND OPENING OF THE NEW PARISH OFFICE. This was a great accomplishment for us in our first year – to renovate the junior high classrooms into our new parish office. It is a source of pride and joy for me to know that we have accomplished this through the help of diligent staff, volunteers and parishioners. It also marks the continuing integration and centralization of the operations of our parish.

ORDINATION OF DEACON JESUS OLIVEROS. Then Deacon Jesus came to us at a time of transition and his presence in our community gave us new energy and purpose, to be a parish where seminarians and transitional deacons can have a positive experience of ministry. In some ways, it helped mark our parish as a formative parish for priestly vocations and watching his transition from deacon to priest made us realize that the priestly vocation is a real community effort with God.

PARISH MISSIONS. Both in the Hispanic and English communities, the Parish Mission this year called us to be open in sharing our own stories to our community, and to allow God to use our individual voices for the work of evangelization. We also reaffirmed that the culture that is growing in our parish is one that is passionate in spreading the Word of God and His Good News in our lives.

FIRST CHRISTMAS, FIRST EASTER. I don't think I have to explain why, but anyway, these days are special every year, and having our first ones meant a lot to a priest like me. And, we did great in our first year of celebrating these highlights of the liturgical year. I will never forget... even the little moments of festive feelings throughout the year, when even in the challenges that we faced, I remember feeling joyfully blessed. Those moments together count for so much, and I will always hold them dear to me as the pastor of this community.

HEARING THAT PRAYERS HAVE BEEN ANSWERED. When I heard the Fr. John Horan was going to be assigned as our new parochial vicar, I was full of joy, thanksgiving and hope. God is good!
