SMALL COMMUNITIES, ANYONE?

Back home in the Philippines, where mostly everyone is Catholic, one of the challenges that the Church faces is how to make everyone feel connected and ministered to. Indeed, it is essential for every Catholic person to feel a sense of belongingness to the church, not just in name, but in practice, in spirituality, in service and in worship. This sense of belongingness is a key to active participation.

Here at Saint John Paul II, it has been in my vision that every family of our parish is engaged in the life of the parish, in various ways. I realize that as we continue to grow as a parish, as registration increases, we have to make sure that each parishioner remains connected.

In my local diocese in the Philippines, a very inspired idea emerged through dialogues with priests, parish leaders and local organization. A model of small Christian communities was designed and developed for all parishes within the diocese, and before they knew it, there was a new sense of connectedness among the people. Inspired the idea of small Christian communities in early apostolic times, neighborhood Catholic groups were formed, composed of smaller number of households, where they are guided to grow together in prayer, to be there with each other in the happy and sad moments of life, to support one another spiritually and materially, and to work together in doing ministry for the bigger church.

In our parish, I am noticing more and more that small communities are forming because of our ministries. For example, our Bible Study groups go beyond simply studying the Bible together with Jacob Levy. It seems that they have moved toward becoming a support system with one another as well. It seems that the same concept is emerging in other groups like clinic and food pantry volunteers, spiritual revival groups like Encuentros Juveniles and the Master's Blend Women's Bible Study Group, new ministries like The Kindness Krew, and even liturgical groups like the Parish Choir. These are some unique models of small communities within our larger community. But I think this idea can still be expanded by actually organizing our families who live close to each other to be literally formed as Neighborhood Small Catholic communities. They can be guided to do some common prayers, devotions, activities, and even liturgies together. Some from our parish leaders and clergy can even pay these neighborhood groups so that they can have some more fellowship and prayer time together.

As we continue with the second year of our parish, I am really convinced that this is an important and effective way to elevate our community-building efforts, coupled with our evangelization and mission programs. And so, I want to take this time to actually encourage our parishioners who know their neighbors who are our parishioners to take the initiative to organize themselves and become animators of community-building within our parish family. I also hope that this will awaken some interest from others, who may not even be parishioners, to somehow participate in the same effort of community-building and networking with others to form these faith-based small groups of families. I also continue to pray that our parish truly becomes more and more a happy, healthy and holy place for the gathering of God's people, whether it is within the confines of our parish grounds, or in the neighborhoods around us. God bless JPII parish!

PEQUEÑAS COMUNIDADES, HAY ALGUIEN?

En las Filipinas, donde vivía, la mayoría de la población es Católica, uno de los retos que afronta a la Iglesia es el cómo facilitar a la gente en sentirse en casa y cómo suministrarlos. En realidad eso es esencial para cada persona Católica en darles un sentido de pertenencia en la iglesia, no solo de nombre, pero en práctica, en espiritualidad, en servicio y en culto. Este sentido de pertenencia es la llave a una participación activa.

Aquí en San Juan Pablo II, ha sido mi deseo que toda familia esté comprometida en la vida de la parroquia, según las registraciones van aumentando, debemos asegurarnos que cada feligrés permanezca en comunicación.

En mi diócesis en las Filipinas, una idea resaltó en diálogo con los sacerdotes, con líderes parroquiales y organización local. Un modelo de pequeñas comunidades Cristianas fue diseñada y desarrollada para todas las parroquias dentro de la diócesis, e inesperadamente, había un sentido de enlace entre la gente. La idea de pequeñas comunidades Cristianas fue inspirada por las comunidades apostólicas, grupos Católicos formados en vecindades que son guiados para crecer juntos en oración, allí están unidos en los momentos alegres y los momentos tristes de la vida, apoyando uno al otro espiritualmente y materialmente, y trabajando unidos en el ministerio para la iglesia.

En nuestra parroquia, me estoy dando cuenta que pequeñas comunidades se van formando según los ministerios. Por ejemplo, grupos de estudio de Biblia con Jacob Levy. Parece que ellos van avanzando hacia la formación de un grupo de apoyo. Parece que este concepto va resaltando en otros grupos, como en la clínica, los voluntarios en la despensa de alimentos, grupos de renovación como los Encuentros Juveniles y el Grupo de Mujeres de Estudio Bíblico del Master's Blend, nuevos ministerios como el Grupo de Amabilidad, y hasta grupos litúrgicos como el Coro Parroquial. Estos son algunos modelos de pequeñas comunidades dentro de nuestra comunidad más extensa. Pero pienso que esta idea todavía puede extenderse y organizar a nuestras familias que viven en proximidad una a la otra en Pequeñas Comunidades Católicas de Vecindad. Pueden ser guiados en rezar algunas oraciones que ya conocen, devociones, actividades, y hasta tener juntos sus propias liturgias. Algunos de nuestros líderes parroquiales y el clero pueden recompensar a estos grupos vecindarios para que ellos puedan tener mas tiempo juntos en amistad y oración.

Según continuamos en el segundo año parroquial, estoy seguro que una manera importante y efectiva para elevar nuestros esfuerzos en formar comunidad, juntamente con nuestros programas de evangelización y programas de misión. Así es que, quiero tomar esta oportunidad para actualmente animar a nuestros feligreses que conocen a sus vecinos que son feligreses, a tomar la iniciativa para organizarse y ser animadores en formar comunidad dentro de nuestra familia parroquial. También espero que esto despierte algo de interés para otros, aunque no sean feligreses, para participar en el mismo esfuerzo en formar pequeñas comunidades y enlazar una redecilla con otros para formar estos pequeños grupos de familias de fe. También continuó en oración para que nuestra parroquia llegue a ser cada vez más y más alegre, saludable y un lugar santo donde se reúne el pueblo de Dios, ya se reúnan en los confines de nuestro campo parroquial, o en vecindades a nuestro alrededor. Dios bendiga la parroquia de JPII!




A Message from Deacon Greg Clodi
