WHY DO WE DO THE THINGS THAT WE DO?



PORQUE HACEMOS LAS COSAS QUE HACEMOS?

It's August! We are gearing up again toward our new high season here at Saint John Paul II. Schools will begin again in just a few weeks, our faith formation program is setting up fine, our RCIA programs will reconvene with a new batch of candidates or catechumens, and we are also doing a lot of review, training or re-training of liturgical ministries. Our leadership goals continue, while new ideas spring up through parishioners' initiatives and with the creative minds of our leadership teams. Saint John Paul II is on the takeoff, even though our summer months have not been wanting of their own exciting events.

Dear Church, I want to ask us a very basic question that we should continually to ask through the years to come: why do we do all these?

At the final mass of the Hearts of Hope Mission to Pembroke, I told our young people about the importance of clarifying their motivations for joining a parish-based youth group mission. Because such clarity makes a big difference. **WE ARE NOT JUST A SOCIAL MOVEMENT NOR A CHARITABLE ORGNIZATION.** We are the **CHURCH**, and that makes a big difference in the way we view the things that we do. Everything that we are is about loving God, and everything that we do needs to begin from that.

We have a food pantry, a free clinic and a clothing drive is at its initial stage. We have Hispanic family wellness ministry, and we have many events for families at large. We can be the United Nations of Kankakee for all intents and purposes but if none of these is springing from our love of God and our desire to deepen our spiritual life, expressed through works of mercy for the Lord, we have lost it, and we are lost in the jungle of this culture. **WE ARE FIRST AND FOREMOST THE DISCIPLES OF JESUS, THE FRIENDS OF JESUS, WHO ASKS US ALL TO DO THIS IN LOVE AS HE HAS DONE.** He is the model, the purpose, the sublime reference point of all the things that we do.

That is why it is important to ask why we do the things that we do. As your priests, Fr. John and I spend time to refocus our thoughts, our hearts and our utmost being. When we pray night prayer together, I recognize us naturally taking a long pause together, and in those moments of quiet prayer, we go deep into ourselves to ask how we have remained faithful to responding the question of Jesus: "Do you love me, more than these?"

Mind you, with my God-given gift of discernment, it is not very hard for me to discern when we are doing this collectively and individually. If there is any part of our parish that is unhappy, unkind, unloving, miserable, divisive, or remotely unchristian, it is always because they have lost their way in attaching themselves to the **ONLY** reason why they are doing any of these – Jesus Christ! I ask each of us, dear St. John Paul II parishioners, to never forget to ask this question over and over again. And I pray that we can say tirelessly and joyfully that the one and only reason is Jesus Christ.

El año escolar de nuevo comienza en unas semanas, nuestro programa de formación de fe se está preparando, el programa RICA de nuevo se reúne con nuevos candidatos o catecúmenos, y también estamos revisando, entrenando o re-entrenando los ministerios litúrgicos. Porque esa clarificación es sumamente importante. **NO SOMOS SIMPLEMENTE UN MOVIMIENTO SOCIAL NI TAMPOCO SOMOS UNA ORGANIZACIÓN CARITATIVA.** Somos la **IGLESIA**, y ésa es una gran diferencia en la manera en que vemos las cosas que hacemos. Todo lo que hacemos és porque amamos a Dios, y todo lo que hacemos tiene allí su principio.

Tenemos una despensa de alimentos, una clínica gratis y estamos por iniciar una despensa de ropa. Tenemos muchos eventos para familias, y también tenemos un ministerio para el bienestar de familias Hispanas. Muy bien podemos ser las Naciones Unidas de Kankakee por todas nuestras intenciones y objetivos pero si todo esto no tiene su fuente en nuestro amor por Dios y nuestro deseo de profundizar nuestra vida espiritual que se expresa por medio de trabajos de misericordia por el Señor, entonces ya estamos perdidos, y estamos en la selva de ésta cultura. **PRIMERAMENTE SOMOS DISCÍPULOS DE JESÚS, LOS AMIGOS DE JESÚS, QUIÉN NOS PIDE HACER TODO CON AMOR COMO ÉL LO HA HECHO.** Él es el modelo, el objetivo, el punto sublime de referencia en todo lo que hacemos.

Por eso es importante preguntarnos, el porqué hacemos lo que hacemos. Como sus sacerdotes, el Padre Juan y yo pasamos tiempo para enfocar nuestros pensamientos, nuestros corazones y todo nuestro ser. Cuando juntos rezamos la oración nocturna, pasamos una larga pausa orando en silencio, nos recogemos profundamente y nos preguntamos, cómo hemos permanecido fieles en responder a la pregunta de Jesús: "Me amas a mí, más que a éstos?"

Saben ustedes, que con el don de discernimiento que Dios me ha dado, es fácil para mí discernir cuando hacemos esto colectivamente e individualmente. Si hay algunos feligreses que no se sienten feliz, que no son bondadosos, no son amables, se sienten miserables, divididos o alejados no-cristianos hacia nosotros, siempre es porque han perdido su camino en enlazarse a la **ÚNICA** razón de porqué hacemos lo que hacemos – ¡Jesucristo! Debemos recordarnos estimados feligreses de San Juan Pablo II, nunca olvidar en hacer ésta pregunta constantemente. Y ruego que podamos sin cansancio y con alegría que, la única razón es Jesucristo.
