THE LEGACY OF FR. DENNIS SETTLES



LA HERENCIA DEL PADRE DENNIS SETTLES

There are many priests that come and go in a parish community, priests assigned to serve the needs of the local Catholic community. Priests have the privilege of leaving some important things behind just by virtue of their ministries, they may bring more people to faith, deepen people's devotions and help in the temporal and spiritual needs of the people. Priests leave a mark in the community, and there are those that REALLY leave a mark. Fr. Dennis Settles is that kind of a priest. He leaves a mark!

A SPIRITUAL FATHER. When I visited him at St. Mary's Hospital a few months ago, before he was moved to Merkle in Clifton, he was in good spirits. He was making joke after joke, and had a very light-hearted conversation with me. He was optimistic, and happy. I told him that we are praying for him, and he bowed, and said, "I know..." He was grateful for all the prayers and thoughtfulness of people everywhere, but especially the parishioners of St. John Paul II, and former St. Martin parishioners, who were always there for him. I mentioned Seminarian Michael Groth to him, because I knew Michael was just there to visit him, thinking that his health was very critical. Fr. Dennis's voice started cracking, and as soon as he tried to say a word about Michael, he was weeping. He wanted to be there for his ordination, he wanted to continue to support him, and to be there for him, as he always was, when Michael was a young student, and he was inspiring him about becoming a priest. So close yet so far from that ordination, Fr. Dennis was going to be there. Not even death would prevent him from being there. And it is very evident that he loved Michael like his own child, and is very proud of him. I believe that this is one of his greatest legacies as a priest. He has surrounded himself with the spirit of his role as a spiritual father to so many, that many people feel connected with him is this way.

A HUMBLE, SIMPLE MAN OF GOD. Anticipating his funeral service, and all the things that would happen when he died, Fr. Dennis told Deacon Greg, "Keep it simple, like how I lived my life and my priesthood." One thing that was always clear with me about Fr. Dennis was that he never fussed about anything, nor did he like drawing attention to himself. He does his part and just takes the last seat. This sense of simplicity and humility can possibly come only from the heart of his spirituality. This is something that I will always remember about him, because I do believe that Fr. Dennis' humility is the closest image we have of God. From his humility flows all his dedication and love for his ministry as a priest, and I know that all the way to the very end, he always longed to celebrate one more mass if he could.

Last weekend, Deacon Greg and I were talking about Fr. Settles. I was asking him how his visit went. Deacon Greg asked him, what he would tell people if they asked how he is doing. Father Dennis said, "Tell them that I'm well..." I am convinced that he is well, and that now and forevermore, he is empowered to be able to serve his beloved family and church community more now than he ever did before. May He rest in peace. Father Dennis, we love you and honor you in our hearts forever.

UN PADRE ESPIRITUAL. Cuando lo visité hace unos meses en el Hospital Sta. María, antes de mudarse a Merkle en Clifton, él se sentía con ánimo. Él decía una broma tras otra, y conversaba levemente conmigo. Él era optimista, y alegre. Le dije que estábamos rezando por él, y él inclinó la cabeza diciendo, "Yo lo sé..." Él estaba muy agradecido por todas las oraciones y amabilidad tanta de gente, pero especialmente de los feligreses de San Juan Pablo II, y de la comunidad anterior de San Martín, quiénes estaban allí a su disposición. Le mencioné el seminarista Michael Groth, porque Michael estuvo allí a visitarlo, porque pensaba que estaba muy delicado de salud. La voz del Padre Dennis se quebrantó, y cuando quiso decir algo de Michael, comenzó a llorar. Él quería estar allí en su ordenación, él quería seguir apoyándolo y, como siempre estar allí a su disposición, como lograba hacerlo cuando Michael era un estudiante joven, él lo inspiraba hacia el sacerdocio. Tan cerca y a la vez tan lejos de esa ordenación, pero el Padre Dennis iba a estar allí. Ni la muerte podría prevenir su presencia. Y, era evidente que él apreciaba mucho a Michael como si fuera su propio hijo y esta muy orgulloso de él. Yo creo que ésta es una de sus más grandes herencias como sacerdote. Él se entregó totalmente a muchos en su rol como padre espiritual, y mucha gente siente este conexión con él.

UN HUMILDE, HOMBRE SENCILLO DE DIOS. Anticipando servicio fúnebre, y todas las cosas que pasarían antes de morir, el Padre Dennis le dijo al Diácono Greg, "Mantén todo simple, así como pasé mi vida y mi sacerdocio." Una cosa que vi claramente en el Padre Dennis es que él nunca se enfadaba por cualquier cosa que pasaba, y nunca llamaba la atención para sí mismo. Él hacía lo que le pertenecía y luego tomaba el último asiento. Este sentido de simplicidad y humildad viene solamente del corazón de su espiritualidad. Esto es algo que siempre recordaré del Padre Dennis porque yo creo en realidad que su humildad es la imagen más cercana que tenemos de Dios. De su humildad fluye toda su dedicación y amor por su ministerio sacerdotal, y sé que hasta el final de su vida, siempre deseaba, si fuera posible, celebrar la santa misa una vez mas.

El pasado fin de semana, el Diácono Greg y yo hablábamos acerca del Padre Settles. Yo le preguntaba cómo le fue en su visita. El Diácono Greg le preguntó, que debería decir a la gente si le preguntaba cómo estaba. El Padre Dennis respondió, "Diles que estoy bien..." Yo estoy convencido que él está bien, y que ahora y para siempre, él tiene el poder de servir a su amada familia comunidad parroquial más ahora que antes. Que descanse en paz. Padre Dennis, lo apreciamos y lo honramos para siempre en nuestros corazones.
