A CASE FOR FAITH

It's been a great few months since getting ordained a priest and coming to JP2. 3 months are in the books for me here!

A big part of my newly ordained ministry has been what *really feels like* constant preaching. Between Sundays and daily masses, baptisms and quinceañera's (and whatever else in between), I think I've been stretched most in this daily effort to share the Gospel. I'm glad I haven't run out of ideas yet...but I know it is because God is leading me in sharing His message.

Even so, one theme that I think has been consistent in my preaching in these early months has been the goodness and importance of faith. I think of it like my first priority in sharing the Gospel: to encourage a mature acceptance of *this divine gift that lifts up our intellect and connects us to God*.

I don't know what the next "theme" of preaching will be...I am waiting for God's inspiration there. So I thought I would take this opportunity to write more directly about faith and to try and summarize the meaning of this gift.

Faith is one of the three *Theological Virtues* (along with Hope and Love). That means that unlike other virtues that we can practice and grow in by our own effort (think practicing a sport or piano), this strength is only received as a gift from God. Faith can be defined as "the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1) as well as an assent of our intellect and will to divinely revealed truths (CCC 143). *It is by faith that we can know God and be in relationship with our Lord*.

The Catechism teaches that faith is *our response to God's invitation* to share in His life. It's right to think of faith as something both *intellectual* and *personal*. While some things in the world can be known by natural science and research, other things are experienced and known in the context of a relationship. For example, while a biologist could tell us the genetic make-up of a certain tree, it's different from the knowledge of a person who lives alongside the tree and knows its movements and sounds. One is intellectual and the other is personal.

To believe in God as Creator is something that we could reason out from seeing the order of the visible world. And we would not know God as *Father* except by the Scriptures, nor would we know of the *humility of God* to become man and die on a cross except by God's self-revelation in the Son, Jesus. These are points of faith, and they allow a deeper love of God in us, both intellectually and personally. Faith is the interior eye where we can see the Living God and where the soul is awakened in love and praise.

Near the end of John's Gospel, Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to "guide [them] to all truth" (Jn. 16:13). The Holy Spirit is an inspiration for faith since He prays in us and continues to lead us to see God's face. A beautiful prayer for an increase of faith is in words of Philip to Jesus: "Lord, show us the Father..." (Jn. 14:8).

UN MOTIVO PARA LA FE

He pasado 3 meses magníficos aquí en JP2 desde mi ordenación al sacerdocio!

En gran parte de mi recién ministerio sacerdotal ha sido semejante a una constante predicación. Entre domingos misas diarias, bautizos y quinceañeras (y otras cosas entre ellas), creo que me he extendido más en este esfuerzo diario para compartir el Evangelio. Que bueno que todavía he dado abasto con ideas...pero yo sé que es Dios quien me dirige en compartir Su mensaje.

Aún así, un tema que es constante en mi predicación en estos meses ha sido la virtud e importancia de la fe. Pienso en eso como mi primer prioridad compartir el Evangelio: en fomentar una aceptación madura de *éste don divino que eleva nuestro intelecto y nos comunica con Dios*.

No sé cual será el siguiente "tema" de predicación...estoy esperando la inspiración de Dios. Así es que tomo esta oportunidad para escribir más directamente acerca de la fe y tratar de abreviar el significado de este don.

La Fe es una de las tres *Virtudes Teológicas* (juntamente con Esperanza y Caridad o Amor). Eso quiere decir que, a diferencia de otras virtudes que practicamos y en las que crecemos por medio de nuestro esfuerzo (por ejemplo cuando practicamos un deporte o el piano), este esfuerzo solo lo recibimos como un don de Dios. La Fe puede definirse como "La manera de tener lo que esperamos, el medio para conocer lo que no vemos" (Hebreos 11:1) así como aprobación a nuestro intelecto y voluntad a las verdades divinamente reveladas (CCC 143). *Es por medio de la fe que podemos conocer a Dios y estar en relación con nuestro Señor*.

El Catecismo enseña que la fe es *nuestra respuesta a la invitación de Dios* para compartir en Su vida. Es bueno pensar que la fe es algo *intellectual* y *personal*. Mientras algunas cosas en el mundo las conocemos en manera científica, otras cosas las conocemos por medio de relaciones humanas. Por ejemplo, mientras un biólogo puede explicar genéticamente acerca de cierto árbol, eso es diferente al conocimiento de una persona que vive cerca del árbol y conoce sus movimientos y sonidos. El uno es intelectual y el otro es personal.

El creer en Dios como nuestro Creador es algo que podemos razonar, que es diferente a las cosas que vemos en el mundo. Y no podemos conocer a Dios como nuestro Padre, si no fuera por las Escrituras, ni podemos conocer *la humildad* de Dios al ser hombre y morir en la cruz, si no fuera por la revelación personal de Dios por Su Hijo, Jesús. Estas son cosas de fe, que nos permiten tener un amor profundo a Dios, en manera intelectual y personal. La fe es la vista interior donde vemos al Dios Viviente y donde el alma despierta en amor y alabanza.

Casi al final del Evangelio de San Juan, Jesús promete mandarnos el Espíritu Santo, "para guiarnos a la verdad" (Juan 16:13). El Espíritu Santo nos inspira hacia la fe porque Él reza en nosotros y continúa guiándonos a ver el rostro de Dios. Una oración preciosa para aumentar nuestra fe son las palabras de Felipe a Jesús: "Señor, muéstranos al Padre..." (Juan 14:8).


JP2 Summer Staff Outing Starved Rock St. Bede Academy & Abbey




