## THE VALUE OF THE ROSARY

To some who have never developed the discipline of praying the rosary, it might seem like a tedious, boring, and useless repetition of prayers. But for those who know how to really pray the rosary, it can be a really valuable prayer form, a tool for deeper meditation, and can even serve as a way to clear one's mind from distracting mundane thoughts.

In the scriptures, Jesus criticizes the pagans who babble in their prayer in Matthew 6:7. Those who look at the rosary from the outside, it may easily be judged as babbling or vain repetition. Gladly, there is nothing vain or useless at all about the rosary. Those who know the technique of the prayer, the repetition of words, which may also be referred to as "mantra", is a means to center one's mind, like a background music to the prayer action that is taking place. The mind, which is then eased from focusing on the words of the mantra, starts to get preoccupied with reflection, meditation or visioning of the events of the mysteries being prayed for. For example, the mind may be meditating on the event of the transfiguration of Jesus, thinking about the glory of God, maybe thinking about God's assurance of everlasting life. Meanwhile, the tongue is preoccupied in praying the words of the Hail Mary, as a means to center one's thoughts in meditation.

Having just returned from Fatima and Lourdes, it is so encouraging to be surrounded with many people who pray the rosary together in these shrines of devotion. The Blessed Virgin Mary, in both instances, prayed the rosary with the children. Mary in fact clearly asked for the praying of the rosary in Fatima, while in Lourdes, the very first apparition to Bernadette was marked with their praying the rosary.

I am proud to say that here in our parish, we have a very vibrant culture of praying the rosary. Rosary is prayed every morning before the mass begins. We also have a rosary group that gathers to pray in church during the day. We are teaching our children in the faith formation program this year to learn all the prayers that would make a full rosary, so that the children can learn to pray it well. And during this month of the rosary, we recently concluded a Living Rosary, which is really one of the most solemn devotional activities that we do in the year. I am convinced that this is a sign of a healthy devotional life, and the benefits of this prayer form to the whole parish is immeasurable.

This month of October, let us together continue the culture of praying the rosary in our parish. I encourage our parents to even make this a family tradition in the month of October, if not throughout the year. I believe that the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary is very efficacious in leading us in the pathway to Jesus Christ. I re-echo St. John Paul II who wrote in his encyclical on the rosary: "I look to all of you, brothers and sisters of every state of life, to you, Christian families, to you, the sick and elderly, and to you, young people: confidently take up the Rosary once again. Rediscover the Rosary in the light of Scripture, in harmony with the Liturgy, and in the context of your daily lives."

## EL ROSARIO Y SU VALOR

Para algunos que no están acostumbrados a rezar el rosario, es algo aburrido y fastidioso, que no tiene sentido la repetición. Pero para aquellos que de veras saben cómo rezar el rosario, es una oración verdaderamente valiosa, es un medio de una meditación profunda, y también ayuda en aclarar la mente de pensamientos mundanos.

En las escrituras, Jesús critica a los paganos que balbucean en sus oraciones en Mateo 6:7. Aquellos que critican el rosario, fácilmente lo juzgan como un balbucear en su repetición. Alegremente sabemos que no hay nada vano o inútil acerca del rosario. Los que conocen la técnica de la oración, su repetición se puede considerar como "mantra", es un medio de concentración mental, como si fuera una música que toma lugar al fondo de la oración. La mente se siente calmada al no enfocarse en palabras del mantra, empieza a preocuparse con la reflexión, meditación y en visionar los eventos de los misterios que se están rezando. Por ejemplo, meditamos mentalmente el evento de la transfiguración de Jesús, pensando en la gloria de Dios, y quizás pensando en la seguridad de Dios sobre la vida eterna. Entre tanto, la lengua está preocupada en rezar las palabras del Ave María, como medio para centralizarse en meditación.

Como ya he regresado de Fátima y Lourdes, fue un estímulo estar rodeado de tanta gente que reza el rosario unidos en estos santuarios con gran devoción. Inicialmente, la Virgen María, en los dos lugares, rezaba el rosario con los niños. La Santísima Virgen en Fátima pidió que se rezara el rosario, mientras que en Lourdes, en la primera aparición a Bernadette, fue señalado con las dos rezando el rosario.

Con gran alegría, veo que aquí en nuestra parroquia, hay un espíritu vibrante cuando rezamos el rosario. Rezamos el rosario diariamente antes de misa. También tenemos un grupo que se reúne a rezar el rosario en la iglesia durante el día. Estamos enseñando a los niños en el programa de formación de fe, para que aprendan todas las oraciones incluyendo el rosario. Y durante éste mes dedicado al rosario, recién rezamos un Rosario Viviente, que en realidad es una devoción solemne en todo el año. Estoy convencido que ésta es una señal de una saludable vida devocional, y los beneficios de ésta oración para toda la parroquia es incalculable.

En éste mes de octubre, debemos continuar unidos la cultura de rezar el rosario en nuestra parroquia. Pido a los padres de familia fomentar ésta tradición en sus hogares en el mes de octubre, y quizás a través del año. Yo creo que por la intercesión a la Santísima Virgen María es un medio eficaz en nuestro camino a Jesucristo. Doy eco al mensaje de San Juan Pablo II en su encíclica sobre el rosario: "Los veo a todos ustedes, hermanos y hermanas en cada vocación en sus vidas, a ustedes, familias Cristianas, a ustedes, los enfermos y ancianos, y a ustedes, jóvenes: Con confianza agarren su rosario nuevamente. De nuevo descubran el Rosario a luz de las Escrituras, en armonía con la Liturgia, y en contexto con sus vidas cotidianas."

Santísimo San Juan Pablo II, te pedimos que pidas por nosotros para que por tu gran ejemplo:






