HAPPY FEAST DAY, JP2!



Happy feast day, St. John Paul III! Happy feast, my dear parishioners! One of the great things about having a parish named after a saint of our own time is that we feel very much connected with him historically, and therefore, we can feel so much more connected to his legacy and the witness of his holy life. What do you know about him, Church? What are the things about him that inspire you to be a better disciple of Jesus?

I remember vividly that he specifically whispered words of blessing to me back in 2003. He looked at me directly in the eye as I sat beside his chair, and told me words of blessings. I don't know that exact words, but I remember two words: "bless" and "Mary". I knew he was giving me a Marian blessing, even though he could not have known that I am a self-professed Marian priest just like him.

I remember feeling like I was lifted off from the ground when he laid his hand on my head. There was this shock, this sense of being lifted up, or a feeling like I was floating, so that I did not know what to do other than to look away and internalize that moment.

I also remember feeling so excited when, in our second audience with him, he gave each one of us a rosary. He repeated another blessing prayer over and over again as he handed a rosary to each of us in the class, and through the years, that rosary has been a constant reminder of that short but very powerful encounter with our patron saint. Just two years after that encounter, he passed away in the Vatican on April 2, 2005, and eventually would be canonized a saint on April 27, 2014 by Pope Francis. We were all witnesses to the unfolding of the story of a saint in our midst, in our time, and I know many people throughout the world were inspired by him, and desired to seek holiness of life because of his example.

These days, as the pastor of the first and only St. John Paul II parish in the Chicago land Area, I find it a great privilege and honor to be the one to enshrine him as a patron for the faithful. We are all being called to be ambassadors of the Christian virtues that he modeled for the church as a human being, as a priest, as a pope, and now, as a saint. We are being called to keep his legacy alive in the Church and in the world, beginning with teaching our children and our youth about his special love of God and His Church.

Happy feast day, my dear Church! I spent some time thinking about my storyline here in Kankakee, and everything that led to where we are today as a parish of St. John Paul II, and I am overwhelmed with thanksgiving for all the many things that brought us to where we are today. It is one that is full of God's providence amidst all the challenges along the way. It is one that is full of joy and spiritual moments, and I am glad that in the spirit of our patron saint, we can say that, one moment in time, we are here together celebrating this beautiful story. God bless our parish! St. John Paul II, pray for us.

Recuerdo que me sentía como elevado del piso cuando él impuso su mano sobre mi cabeza. Fue como un choque eléctrico, esta sensación de ser elevado, como si estuviera flotando, y no sabía que hacer más que guardar el momento.

También recuerdo sentirme tan emocionado en nuestra segunda audiencia con él, cuando nos dio un rosario a cada uno, después de darnos el rosario, él repetía otra bendición a cada uno de nuestra clase. A través de los años, el rosario es un constante recuerdo de ese día del poderoso encuentro con nuestro santo patrono. Después de dos años de ése memorable encuentro, él falleció en el Vaticano el 2 de abril de 2005, y su canonización como santo fue el 27 de abril de 2014 por el Papa Francisco. Todos fuimos testigos del despliegue de la historia de un santo, de nuestro tiempo, y yo sé que mucha gente a través del mundo fue inspirada por él, y desean una santidad de vida por su ejemplo.

Estos días, como su pastor de la primera y única parroquia San Juan Pablo II en toda el área circunvecina de Chicago, lo considero de gran privilegio y honor de tenerlo como patrono para los fieles. Todos somos llamados a ser embajadores de las virtudes Cristianas que él modeló para la iglesia como ser humano, como sacerdote, como papa, y ahora, como santo. Somos llamados a mantener su legado viviente en la Iglesia y en el mundo, empezando con la enseñanza a nuestros niños y a la juventud acerca de su amor especial a Dios y a Su Iglesia.

¡Felicidades, mi estimada Iglesia! Pasé tiempo pensando en mi historia aquí en Kankakee, y todo lo sucesivo que nos llevó a donde estamos hoy como parroquia de San Juan Pablo II, y me siento abrumado con agradecimiento por tantas cosas que nos ha traído al día de hoy. Es un día repleto de la providencia de Dios juntamente con todos los retos que nos acompañan. Asimismo, nos encontramos con gran alegría y momentos espirituales, y tengo gusto que con el espíritu de nuestro santo patrono, podemos decir que, en dado momento, estamos aquí unidos celebrando esta maravillosa historia. Que Dios bendiga nuestra parroquia! San Juan Pablo II, ruega por nosotros.


