WHEN EVERYBODY FINALLY DID IT: Thoughts on Ministry Sign-Up Weekend

This weekend, we invite our parish to become involved or more involved in our ministry.

A few years ago, I made a presentation to the leaders of the churches here in Kankakee that one of the signs of a healthy and thriving parish is the level of volunteerism of parishioners. Pastors like myself tend to ask this question when we are considering to take a pastoral position in one of the parishes of our diocese: How involved are the people? The reason is simple. We know how a parish can accomplish so much when people are participating in ministry, and we also know how disheartening and disempowering it is when no one participates.

Many of you may have heard the story of the four friends: Matt Somebody, Bill Everybody, Jim Anybody and Joe Nobody. But no one has heard of the fifth friend who passed away: Sam Someone Else, who went with them to the same church. When there was a job to do in church, a need to be filled or a place of leadership, one name was always given by the parishioners: Someone Else. It was a popular response. Everybody always wanted Someone Else to do everything. Everybody also thought that Someone Else could be the largest donor of time and money. Whenever there was a financial need, Everybody thought that Anybody could make up the difference, and so, Everybody thought that Somebody or Someone Else would do it. But in the end, Nobody did. Nobody responded, Nobody did everything, Nobody cared, Nobody participated, and Nobody was there for anything. And now that Everybody can no longer expect Someone Else to do what needs to be done, we can all guess who did it – Nobody!

The work that we do as a parish community requires that we all do our part in making it work well. Being part of the Church is not only about coming to mass on Sunday, but being part of accomplishing its mission and purpose in the world today, beginning from our own community here in Kankakee, beginning with our own families, and our small groups. And so I want to say thank you to the many who already volunteer one way or the other in our various ministries, and I encourage the others who have yet to bring their time and talent to the community to prayerfully consider doing more. We need you, dear parishioners, to accomplish what God is asking us to do as a parish. May you never falter in your generosity, and may the giving of yourself bring you joy. God bless our parish!

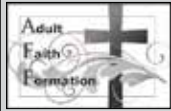
