

It is also important to try our very best to eliminate every possible hindrance from receiving the Lord in holy communion, but ordering our sacramental life, by trying our best to be less unworthy of this gift, and to make sure that we are prepared to receive him through the sacrament of reconciliation (confession).

**BLESSINGS.** Through the year, we prayed together, sang together, partaken of Word and Sacrament together, and exchanged peace and good will with one another. For me as a priest, this is the ultimate blessing – that I have been a witness of how our liturgies have been God's venue for His abundant blessings. And so, as we finish this liturgical year with this solemnity of Christ the King, I pray that you have in your hearts, my dear parishioners, the sense of **GRATITUDE** for what God has done, a sense of **PRIDE** that we have been given this privilege, and a sense of **COMMITMENT** to dedicate our lives to keeping our church alive for the future generation.

I say thank you to our ministers and volunteers who have made our liturgies alive, beautiful and full of the Spirit. I am confident that our King is pleased by the efforts that we have offered. God bless our parish! Praise and glory to Christ our King!
