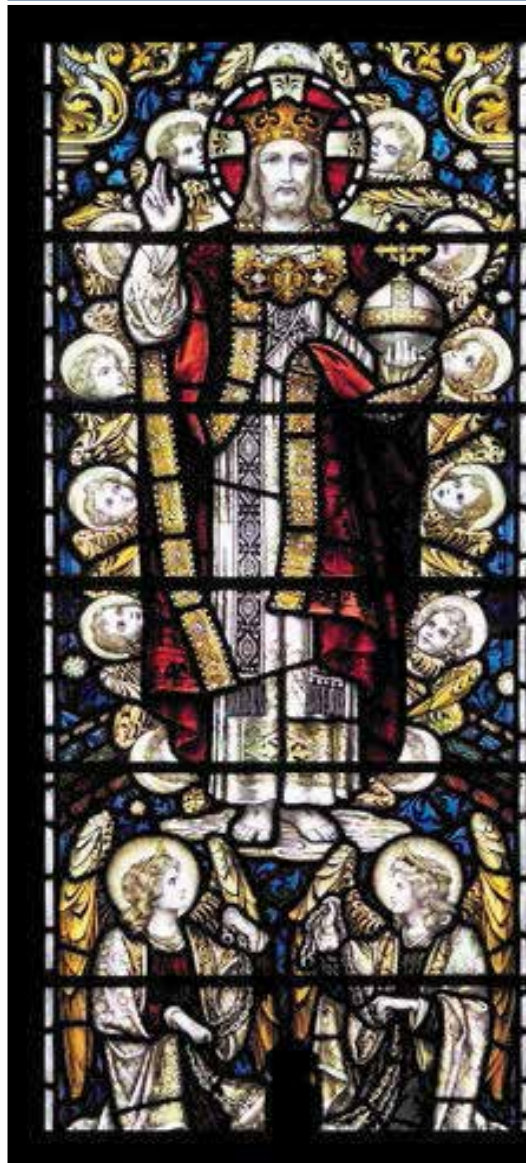

THE POWER OF THE WORD. Listening to God's Word proclaimed at every mass is something very powerful. For me as a priest, this is the ultimate blessing – that I have been a witness of how our liturgies have been God's venue for His abundant blessings. And so, as we finish this liturgical year with this solemnity of Christ the King, I pray that you have in your hearts, my dear parishioners, the sense of GRATITUDE for what God has done, a sense of PRIDE that we have been given this privilege, and a sense of COMMITMENT to dedicate our lives to keeping our church alive for the future generation.

I say thank you to our ministers and volunteers who have made our liturgies alive, beautiful and full of the Spirit. I am confident that our King is pleased by the efforts that we have offered. God bless our parish! Praise and glory to Christ our King!

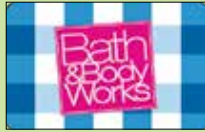
