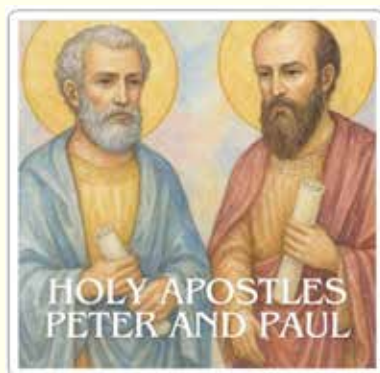

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the chief apostles who were both martyred in Rome around the year 64 for their belief in Christ. Paul was responsible for bringing the faith to the Gentiles, traveling and writing letters, even while imprisoned for the faith. Peter was the chief apostle whose name was changed by the Lord Jesus Himself from Simon to Peter—Peter meaning “rock”—when He said, “And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven” (Mt. 16:18-19). Rome, the city of these great apostles and the center of the Empire, would legalize Christianity 273 years after the apostles’ deaths. Christianity transformed Rome, enriching the culture with generosity, peace, selflessness, and joy. The bishop of the city of Rome has a special place in our faith. We call him the pope. Let us pray for Pope Leo XIV in a special way today. May he continue to bear witness to Christ in such a way that the Kingdom of God, a kingdom of justice, love, mercy, and peace, will spread throughout the world.

I want to thank everybody who participated in and helped with the Corpus Christi procession last Sunday. It was a beautiful celebration with Bishop Spies. May the Eucharist continue to transform us and strengthen us and our communion with one another and with the saints.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos la solemnidad de los santos Pedro y Pablo, los apóstoles principales, quienes fueron martirizados en Roma alrededor del año 64 por su fe en Cristo. Pablo era responsable de llevar la fe a los gentiles, viajando y escribiendo cartas, incluso mientras estaba en la cárcel por su fe. Pedro era el principal apóstol cuyo nombre fue cambiado por el mismo Señor Jesús de Simón a Pedro (Pedro significa “piedra”) cuando dijo, “Y yo te digo a ti que tú eres Pedro y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia. Los poderes del infierno no prevalecerán sobre ella. Yo te daré las llaves del Reino de los cielos; todo lo que ates en la tierra quedará atado en el cielo, y todo lo que desates en la tierra quedará desatado en el cielo” (Mt. 16:18-19). Roma, la ciudad de estos grandes apóstoles y el centro del Imperio, legalizaría el cristianismo 273 años después de la muerte de los apóstoles. El cristianismo transformó a Roma, enriqueciendo la cultura con generosidad, paz, altruismo y alegría. El obispo de la ciudad de Roma ocupa un lugar especial en nuestra fe. Lo llamamos el Papa. Oremos hoy de manera especial por el Papa León XIV. Que continúe dando testimonio de Cristo de tal manera que el Reino de Dios, un reino de justicia, amor, misericordia y paz se extienda por todo el mundo.

Quiero agradecer a todos los que asistieron y ayudaron en la procesión de Corpus Christi el domingo pasado. Fue una hermosa celebración con el Obispo Spies. Que la Eucaristía continúe transformándonos y fortaleciéndonos en nuestra comunión entre nosotros y con los santos.

Our Lady of Fatima and the Five First Saturdays Devotion

When our Lady appeared to three shepherd children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco, in Fatima Portugal, from May to October 1917. She told the children that God wished to establish in the world devotion to her Immaculate Heart.

She warned of a coming chastisement if people did not stop offending God. To prevent this she said, "I will come to ask (1) for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart and (2) the Communion of Reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted and there will be peace. **If not, she [Russia] will spread her errors throughout the world causing wars and persecutions...**"

Pope Francis consecrated Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, our acts of reparation through this devotion are vital to help fulfill Our Lady's requests at Fatima.

The Devotion as Our Lady told Lucia

On the first Saturday during 5 consecutive months, with the intention of making reparation for the offenses against the Immaculate Heart, the devotion consists of:

- 1) Going to Confession (may be fulfilled 8 days before or after, if you are in the state of grace)
- 2) Receiving Holy Communion (can be received at a Saturday evening anticipatory Mass)
- 3) Praying five decades of the Rosary
- 4) Keeping Our Lady company for 15 additional minutes while meditating on one or more mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to her.

Our Lady promised to **"assist them (the faithful that practice this devotion) at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls. This is known as 'the Great Promise'."**

Nuestra Señora de Fátima y la Devoción de los Primeros Cinco Sábados

Cuando Nuestra Señora se apareció a tres niños pastores, Lucía, Jacinta y Francisco, en Fátima Portugal, de mayo a octubre del 1917. Les dijo que Dios deseaba establecer en el mundo la devoción a su Inmaculado Corazón.

Ella advirtió de un castigo que vendría si la gente no dejaba de ofender a Dios. Para evitarlo, dijo: "Vendré a pedir (1) la consagración de Rusia a mi Inmaculado Corazón y (2) la Comunión Reparadora de los Primeros Sábados. Si mis peticiones son escuchadas, Rusia se convertirá y habrá paz. **Si no, [Rusia] difundirá sus errores por el mundo causando guerras y persecuciones...**". El Papa Francisco consagró a Rusia al Inmaculado Corazón de María, nuestros actos de reparación a través de esta devoción son vitales para ayudar a cumplir las peticiones de Nuestra Señora en Fátima.

La Devoción como Nuestra Señora dijo a Lucía

El primer sábado durante 5 meses consecutivos, con la intención de reparar las ofensas contra el Inmaculado Corazón, la devoción consiste en:

- 1) Confesarse (puede cumplirse 8 días antes o después, si se está en estado de gracia)
- 2) Recibir la Sagrada Comunión (se puede recibir en la Misa anticipada del sábado por la tarde)
- 3) Rezar cinco decenas del Rosario
- 4) Acompañar a la Virgen durante 15 minutos más, meditando uno o varios misterios del Rosario, con el fin de desagraviarla.

La Virgen prometió "asistir a los fieles que practican esta devoción en la hora de la muerte con todas las gracias necesarias para la salvación de sus almas". Esto se conoce como "la Gran Promesa".
