Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, on the Feast of the Epiphany, we recall the Magi following the star to a house in Bethlehem where they found the child Jesus with the Blessed Mother. Like the Wise Men, we are on a journey, and our destination, the purpose of our lives, is found in the child who rested in the arms of His mother Mary: Jesus Christ, our Lord. Jesus is the one who brings true joy, peace, and salvation to our souls. In Bethlehem, the Magi found Him. They found the King of kings in a humble home. They found God who made His dwelling among us. God has entered our world and our history so that we may enter into an eternal friendship with Him. Upon finding the Messiah, the Magi offered gifts to the Christ Child and adored Him. May we be led throughout the year by the star of the Church to encounter Christ, adore Him, and please Him by our lives.

There is a tradition to announce on this feast day the moveable feasts throughout the year. The feast days of the year guide us in entering into the mystery of salvation and God's love and in following our Lord. I now share with you the Announcement of Easter and the Moveable Feasts:

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior. **On the 5th day of March will fall Ash Wednesday**, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. **On the 20th day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.** **On the 1st day of June will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.** **On the 8th day of June, the feast of Pentecost.** **On the 22nd day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.** **On the 30th day of November**, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Hoy es la fiesta de la Epifanía, cuando recordamos a los Reyes Magos que seguían la estrella hacia una casa en Belén, donde encontraron al niño Jesús con la Santísima Madre. Como los Reyes Magos, estamos en viaje y nuestro destino, el propósito de nuestras vidas, se encuentra en el niño quien descansa en los brazos de Su madre María: Jesucristo nuestro Señor. Él es el que trae verdadera alegría, paz y salvación a nuestras almas. Los magos lo encontraron en Belén. Encontraron al Rey de reyes en un hogar humilde. Encontraron a Dios quien hizo Su morada entre nosotros. Dios ha entrado a nuestro mundo e historia para que podamos entrar en una amistad eterna con Él. Al encontrar al Mesías, los Reyes Magos ofrecieron regalos al Niño Jesús y lo adoraron. Que la estrella de la Iglesia nos guíe durante todo el año para encontrarnos con Cristo, adorarlo y agradarlo con nuestras vidas.

Existe la tradición de anunciar en este día las fiestas móviles a lo largo del año. Los días festivos del año nos guían para entrar en el misterio de la salvación y el amor de Dios y, para seguir a nuestro Señor. Ahora comparto con ustedes el Anuncio de la Pascua y Fiestas Móviles:

Queridos hermanos: La gloria del Señor se ha manifestado y se continuará manifestando entre nosotros, hasta el día de su retorno glorioso. En la sucesión de las diversas fiestas y solemnidades del tiempo, recordamos y vivimos los misterios de la salvación. El centro de todo el año litúrgico es el Triduo Pascual del Señor crucificado, sepultado y resucitado, que este año culminará en la **Noche santa de Pascua que, con gozo celebraremos el día 20 de abril**. Cada domingo, Pascua semanal, la santa Iglesia hará presente este mismo acontecimiento, en la cual Cristo ha vencido el pecado y la muerte. De la Pascua fluyen, como su manantial, todos los demás días santos: **Celebraremos el Miércoles de Ceniza, comienzo de la Cuaresma, el día 5 de marzo. La Ascensión del Señor, este año será celebrada el día 1 de junio. El domingo de Pentecostés, este año lo celebraremos el 8 de junio. El primer domingo de Adviento, lo celebraremos el día 30 de noviembre.** También, en las fiestas de la santísima Virgen María, madre de Dios, de los apóstoles, de los santos y en la conmemoración de todos los fieles difuntos, la Iglesia, peregrina en la tierra, proclama la Pascua de su Señor. A Él, el Cristo glorioso, el que era, el que es y el que vendrá, al que es Señor del tiempo y de la historia, todo honor y toda gloria por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.


