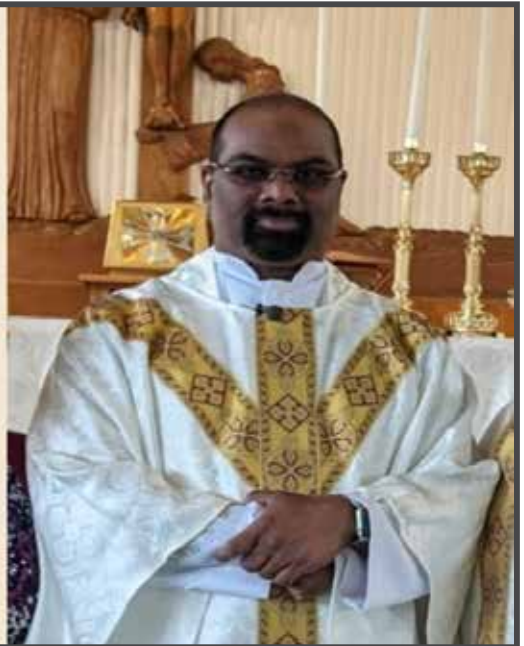

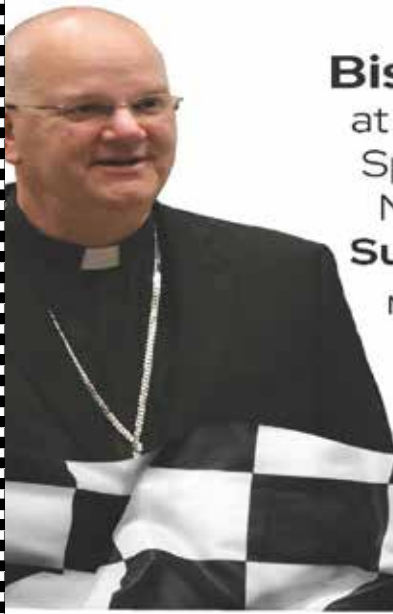

Spiritual Adoption Program

Here is what your 3 month spiritually adopted baby is doing right now.

Your baby is quite active in the womb now -although his mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. What a miracle he is!

Tamaño: cerca de 3 pulgadas; peso: cerca de 1 onza. El bebé ya puede parpadear, tragar y mover la lengua. Se duerme y se despierta. Se forman las uñas de los dedos de las manos y los pies. Ya tiene sus huellas digitales que son únicas. También es sensible al tacto y cogerá con mano firme cualquier objeto que se le ponga en la palma de la mano. "Respira" el líquido amniótico para ayudar a desarrollar y fortalecer el sistema respiratorio, pero el oxígeno que necesita lo obtiene a través del cordón umbilical. ¡Qué milagro es él!

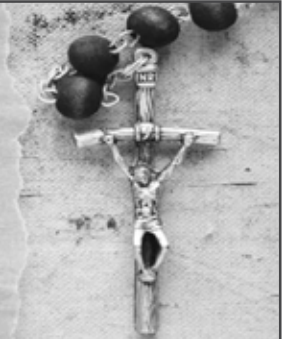
