1. Descendit de caelis Salvator mundi. Gaudeamus!

The Saviour of the world has come down from heaven. Let us rejoice! This proclamation, filled with deep rejoicing, echoed in the night of Bethlehem. Today the Church renews it with unchanged joy: the Saviour is born for us! A wave of tenderness and hope fills our hearts, together with an overpowering need for closeness and peace. In the crib we contemplate the One who stripped himself of divine glory in order to become poor, driven by love for mankind. Beside the crib the Christmas tree, with its twinkling lights, reminds us that with the birth of Jesus the tree of life has blossomed anew in the desert of humanity. The crib and the tree: precious symbols, which hand down in time the true meaning of Christmas!

2. In the heavens there echoes the proclamation of the angels: "To you is born in the city of David a Saviour, who is Christ the Lord" (Lk 2:11). What wonder! By being born in Bethlehem, the Eternal Son of God has entered into the history of each person living on the face of the earth. He is now present in the world as the one Saviour of humanity. For this reason we pray to him: Saviour of the world, save us!

4. And you, Mary, the Virgin of expectation and fulfilment, who hold the secret of Christmas, make us able to recognize in the Child whom you hold in your arms the heralded Saviour, who brings hope and peace to all. With you we worship him and trustingly say: we need You, Redeemer of man, You who know the hopes and fears of our hearts. Come and stay with us, Lord! May the joy of your Nativity reach to the farthest ends of the universe!



Francesca was born in Chicago where she attended Alvernia High School where she developed a love for consecrated life. She attended Northeastern Illinois University earning her undergraduate degree in Elementary Education and a Master's degree in Special Education. Francesca entered the Monastic Communities of Jerusalem in Paris, France (1985) and remained there for ten years. Due to declining health of her father, Francesca returned home to tend to her father's needs. She was admitted into the Order of Virgins, becoming the first consecrated virgin in the Archdiocese Chicago by Cardinal Francis George on December 1, 2002.

In 2007, Francesca moved to Lombard, Illinois where her consecration was transferred from the Chicago Archdiocese to the Diocese of Joliet. For 20 years, Francesca worked as a special education teacher in Schaumburg, Illinois. During this time, she received certification as a spiritual director and worked as the Director of Religious Education in Sacred Heart parish for nine years.
